 one sail in sight Variation 2 Points Westerly
 Lat By obs 34° 10' North
 Long By obs 26° 11' West

Remarks on Board Tuesday September 6 1836

- 37 First Port light airs from the ESE Stead by S by W
 with all sail set Employed in Ships duty one sail in
 sight middle and latter Port Fine Winds from the
 E by S lower S by W with all drawing sail set at 7 am
 saw a Ship Steaming W by N So ends
 Variation 2 Points Westerly Lat By obs 32° 18' North
 Long By obs 26° 22' West

Remarks on Board Wednesday September 7 1836

- 38 This day Begins with Brisk Winds from the E by S
 lower S by W with all sail set Employed in Ships
 duty at 3 Pm Stead S by W middle and latter Port Heavy
 Winds and Squally Variation 2 Points Westerly So ends
 Lat By obs 29° 36' North
 Long By obs 26° 18' West

Remarks on Board Thursday September 8 1836

- 39 This 24 hours commences with Brisk Gales from the
 East lower S by W Employed in Ships duty middle and
 latter Port much the same Variation 12 Points Westerly
 Lat By obs 27° 08' North
 Long By obs 26° 10' West

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Remarks on Board Friday September 9 1836

- 40 First Port Brisk Winds from the E by E and lower
 lower S by W with all sail set Employed in Ships
 duty middle and latter Port much the same So ends
 Variation 2 Points Westerly Lat By obs 24° 14' North
 Long By obs 26° 13' West

Remarks on Board Saturday September 10 1836

- 41 This 24 hours commences with Treacher Winds from
 the East lower S by W Employed in Ships duty
 middle and latter Port much the same at 7 am the
 Annals Tell over Board Bro't the Ship to the wind
 Board the Boat and got Ann So ends
 Lat By obs 21° 19' North
 Long By obs 26° 15' West
 Variation 1 1/2 Points Westerly

Remarks on Board Sunday September 11 1836

- 42 This day Begins with Brisk Winds from the East lower
 S by W with all drawing sail set middle Port Squally
 Stead S by W latter Port winds ESE and more moderate
 Variation 1 Point Westerly Lat By obs 18° 29' North
 Long By obs 26° 00' West

Remarks on Board Monday September 12 1836

- 43 First Port fine Breeze from the ESE Stead by
 S by W with all sail set at 6 Pm took in the top
 g Sails and Courses Stead S by E at 1 Pm where
 Ship to the W by W at 3 1/2 am where Ship and Stead by
 S by E at daylight made all sail at 7 am made the
 High Land of St Antonio Baring by compass SE distant
 20 miles one sail in sight at noon the South end
 bore S by E distant 16 mile Lat By obs 14° 06' North
 Long By obs 28° 30' West
