by S by E with brisk showers of rain at 4 PM  
change called with the before mention ship which  
was a English Ensign latter part clear winds S by E

Long By S R 20° 43' West

86 all the 24 hours light air and variable heading  
to the SSE 3 sail in sight Lat By S R 5° 09' North

breeze and squally latter part brisk winds  
from the SSW Stead by S by E at 11 am tack

Long By S R 19° 40' West

88 This 24 hours brisk winds from the S by E Stead

Remarks on Board Wednesday September 28, 1836

89 all this day brisk winds from the S by E  
stead by S by E with all sail set so ends  
Lat By S R 2° 40' North  
Long By S R 22° 27' West

Remarks on Board Thursday September 29, 1836

90 This day and 24 hours fine breeze from the S by E  
stead by S by E with all sail set employed in ships  
duty variation 1 Point Westerly  
Lat By S R 1° 12' North  
Long By S R 23° 41' West

Remarks on Board Friday September 30, 1836

91 All the 24 hours fine winds from the S by E Stead  
by S by E with all sail set at 8 am saw black fish  
stead and got one one sail in sight variation  
3/4 Point Westerly Lat By S R 00° 28' South  
Long By S R 24° 00' West

Remarks on Board Saturday October 1, 1836

92 all the 24 hours fine breeze and clear with all  
sail set employed in boiling black fish Stead by  
S by E variation 1/2 Point Westerly so ends  
Lat By S R 2° 09' South  
Long By S R 24° 24' West

Remarks on Board Sunday October 2, 1836

93 This 24 hours brisk winds and clear with all drawing  
sail set Stead by S by E so ends  
Lat By S R 4° 03' South  
Long By S R 24° 59' West
