Remarks on Board Monday October 10 1836  
71 This 24 hours moderate breeze from the ESE  
Stead set by S at 6 am Stead SSW at midnight  
Stead set by S at 8 am Wind head to the West  
all hands Employed in setting up the rigging and  
bending a new huxen Topmast So ends  
Lat By obs 21° 54' South  
Long by obs 28° 38' West

Remarks on Board Tuesday October 11 1836  
72 First Part fine breeze from the North Stead by S  
with all sail set at 6 am wind head to the NW  
The S & Sails accompanied with rain at 8 am wind head  
to the South with strong gusts held all hands and  
for the ship two with West reef main Topmast  
heading W by S latter part more moderate set the  
Topmast double reef Lat By obs 22° 23' South  
Long by obs 27° 37' West

Remarks on Board Wednesday October 12 1836  
73 First Part strong breeze from the S by E Stead by  
SSW with double reef middle and latter part  
more moderate Stead by S Employed in repairing  
the main sail Lat By obs 23° 10' South  
Long by obs 30° 50' West
