Remarks on Board Saturday October 15 1836

76 First part brisk winds from the ESE latter part
with all sail set at midnight took in the flooring
sails with strong gale at 7 am Stead SE by S
Lat By obs 28° 52' South
Long By obs 39° 20' West

Remarks on Board Sunday October 16 1836

77 First part strong gale from the ESE Stead SE
at 6 pm south sea the main topmast with brisk showers
of rain middle part variable winds latter part brisk
winds from the SW Stead by SE in the afternoon
Lat By obs 30° 00' South
Long By obs 38° 48' West

Remarks on Board October 17 1836

78 First part Brisk winds from the SW Stead by SE
at 6 pm took ship to the NW with light winds
latter part squally at 6 am wore ship to the SSE
Lat By obs 30° 31' South
Long By obs 39° 52' West

Remarks on Board Sunday October 18 1836

79 First part Brisk winds from the W by S Stead
by SW at 6 pm south sea the foremast with
Stead by S by E latter part strong gale and squally
with a large sea at 8 am took in the deck beat
Employed in Bending a new Staymast So ends
Lat By obs 32° 08' South
Long By obs 38° 06' West

Remarks on Board Wednesday October 19 1836

80 First part strong gale from the W by S heading
South with a light sea main topmast latter part
more moderate set the foremast that was so ends
Lat By obs 32° 08' South
Long By obs 34° 25' West

Remarks on Board Thursday October 20 1836

81 all the 24 hours strong gale from the W by S
to W by S Stead by South and S by E with light sea
Topmast So ends
Lat By obs 33° 32' South
Long By obs 34° 15' West

Remarks on Board Friday October 21 1836

82 First part strong gale and squally from the W by S
Stead by W latter part steady SW by W Stead by
SE Calm a person and saw fine back So ends
Lat By obs 34° 50' South
Long By obs 33° 46' West

Remarks on Board Saturday October 22 1836

83 First part strong gale from the SW by W Stead by SE
with light sea Topmast saw fine back at 8 pm winds
head to the S by W took ship to the NW middle and latter
part more moderate made all sail but a new
Foremast Employed in Repairing the new foremast
So ends
Lat By obs 35° 01' South
Long By obs 38° 00' West
