saw Phinck and Porpoise Sat By obs 38° 14' South
Long By L. S. 36° 33' West

Remarks on Board Monday October 24 1836

85 First Part moderate winds from the West North by N
from 2 to 4 then SSW from 4 to midnight S by E
with strong gale at 4 am lost reef the Topmast
winds S by E heading NE at 10 am beat the
main Topmast stay with strong gale and a
large sea to end Sat By obs 36° 37' South
Long By L. S. 36° 50' West

Remarks on Board Tuesday October 25 1836

86 First Part Strong Gale from the S by E heading
SE with lost reef Topmast at 8 am winds head
to the South where ship and stood off with
a large sea from 4 to 7 am calm latter part
moderate winds from the W by E calm with
all bracing sail set Employed in repairing the
main Topmast to end Sat By obs 36° 50' South
Long By L. S. 37° 08' West

Remarks on Board Wednesday October 26 1836

87 First Part fine winds from the W by E calm with
with all sail set at 8 am took in the J & J sail with
strong gale with rain at 8 pm double reef the
Topmast and handed the main course at midnight
calm latter part Brisk winds from the W by E
stood by S by E at 11 am took in the J & J sail and
double reef the Topmast with strong gale
Sat By obs 38° 05' South
Long By L. S. 37° 40' West

Bound To The Pacific Ocean in 1836

Remarks on Board Thursday October 27 1836

88 First Part Strong Gale from the S by E stood
by South at 3 pm lost reef the Topmast at 4 took
in the J & J main J sail and Tired the course
at 7 pm took in the main Topmast with strong
gale latter part more moderate at 6 am set
the Topmast lost reef at 7 pm saw a ship on
the northern tack to end Sat By obs 38° 34' South
Long By L. S. 37° 02' West

Remarks on Board Friday October 28 1836

89 First Part Brisk winds from the W by E stood
by South with double reef at 4 pm saw a
Rite Whaler bound for the Fair at 6 am on board
one sail in light middle part light sail and calm
heading to the S by E at 6 am took in Rite Whaler
at 7 pm up the chase and calm on board with Brisk
winds from the W by E stood by S with all bracing
sail set Sat By obs 38° 54' South
Long By L. S. 37° 38' West

Remarks on Board Saturday October 29 1836

90 all the 24 hours moderate winds from the W by E
W by S with all sail set at 6 am saw Rite Whaler
bound for the Fair at 7 am on board kept our course
to end Sat By obs 39° 27' South
Long By L. S. 42° 34' West

Remarks on Board Sunday October 30 1836

91 First Part Brisk winds from the W by E stood
by S with all sail set accompanied with rain
at 4 pm winds head to the W by E with strong
gale and lost reef the Topmast at midnight
took in the J & J main at daylight took
in the West Boat at 7 took in the main Topmast
and lay two with a lost main with several
gales Sat By obs 39° 50' South
Long By L. S. 43° 00' West
