92 First Part Seaver Gails From the SW heading
SE with a West breeze and a large sea saw
a ship to the windward at midnight more moderate
at daylight set the Topmast Mast reef Sails
Part Calm at 11 am took a light breeze from
the WSE Stead W by S and made all sail
Lat By obs 39° 42' South
Long By LK 42° 00' West

Remarks on Board Tuesday October 1 1836

93 First Part brisk winds from the WSE Stead
at 10 am southerly with the topmast reef at
4 by the ship two at 6 took in the main
Topsail with Seaver Gails from the West
Latter Part the rain at 11 am took in the
Staysail
Lat By LK 40° 07' South
Long By LK 41° 58' West

Remarks on Board Wednesday November 2

94 First Part Seaver Gail From the WSW heading
S by E at 4 pm set the Topmast Mast reef at 8 pm
winds head to the W by E accompanied with rain
at 2 am winds head to the West with strong gails
took in the Topmast and lay two under our Storm
Staysails
Lat By obs 40° 48' South
Long By LK 41° 48' West

Remarks on Board Thursday November 3 1836

95 First of the 24 hours strong gails from the
West heading S by W under 3 Staysails with a
large sea latter part more moderate
at 5 pm set the Topmast Mast reef Sails
Lat By obs 41° 10' South
Long By LK 41° 13' West

96 The 24 hours fresh winds from the SSW Stead
by WSW with Mast reef Topmast
Lat By obs 40° 28' South
Long By LK 42° 00' West

Remarks on Board Saturday November 5 1836

97 First Part moderate winds from the WSW Stead by
SW by W with all sail Middle Part strong gail at 8 pm
headed S and in Topmast Mast reef the main
winds WSW heading SSW at daylight more moderate
set the Topmast Mast reef Lat By obs 41° 29' South
Long By LK 42° 41' West

Remarks on Board Sunday November 6 1836

98 First Part strong gail from the WSW Stead
by South under Mast reef Topmast at 4 am took
ship to the WSW and made all sail
Lat By obs 42° 00' South
Long By LK 42° 41' West

Remarks on Board Monday November 7 1836

99 First Part brisk winds from the S by S Stead
by W by W middle Part squally winds S by E Stead
W by S latter Part moderate with all sail
employed in Repairing the Two Topmast Sails
Lat By obs 46° 44' South
Long By LK 44° 56' West

Remarks on Board Tuesday November 8 1836

100 The 24 hours light air and calm from the S by W
heading West at 10 took a breeze from the W by W
Stead by WSW with all drawing sail set
employed in Repairing Sails Sails
Lat By obs 42° 04' South
Long By LK 46° 26' West
