

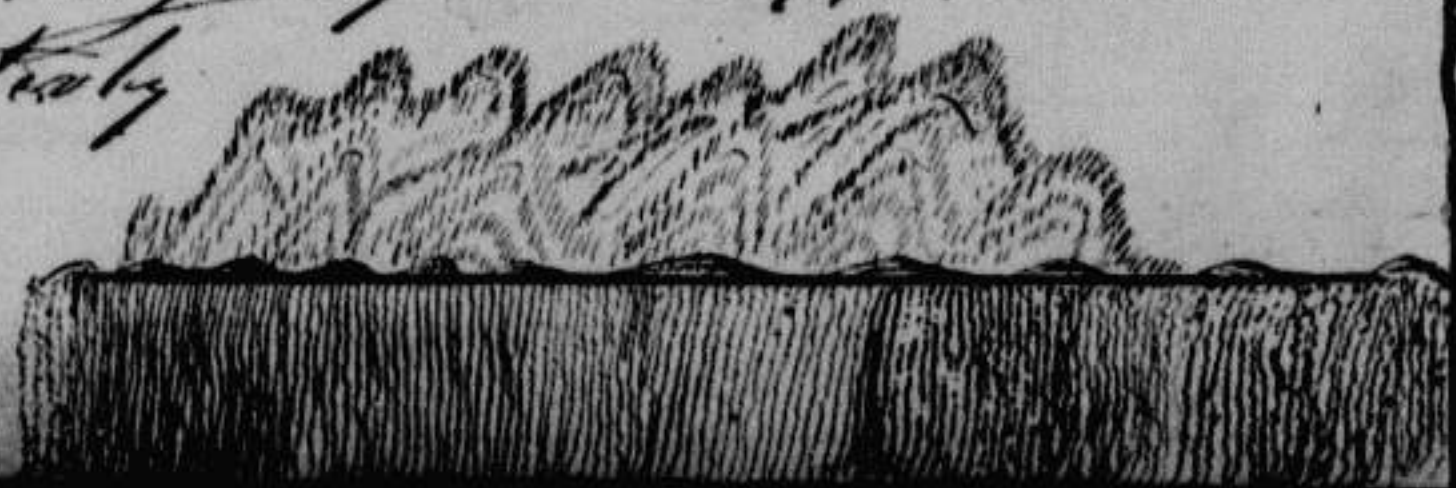
# Ship Genl Jackson From Bristol R.I

Remarks on Board Saturday December 24 1836  
147 The 24 hours light winds from the South  
Employed in Boiling at 8 am finished and  
stood W by E. Saw a number of finbacks  
Lat by obs 34° 48' South  
Long by Lardner 79° 48' West

Remarks on Board Sunday December 25 1836  
148 The 24 hours brisk winds from the S by E  
stood W by E at 4 pm made the Island of  
Juan Fernandez bearing W by E distant 45 miles  
at 8 am lay to heading SW at 1 am where  
ship and heading E by E at 4 am stood W by E  
at 10 am the Island bore East distant 10 miles  
altitude for the Crater found the Long 79° 18' West  
Long of the land 79° 06' East  
Lat by obs 33° 35' South

Remarks on Board Monday December 26 1836  
149 at 12 mid sent 2 boats on shore at San Diego  
leaf Bay ship standing off and on the E side  
at 5 pm the boats returned with a boat  
40 fish at 8 stood W by E with brisk  
winds from the S by E at 8 am lost sight of the  
land bearing SW distant 18 miles for  
latter part much the same variation  
1 Point East by Lat by obs 32° 15' South  
Long by Lardner 79° 25' West

Remarks on Board Tuesday December 27 1836  
150 all the 24 hours brisk winds from the  
S by E stood W by E at 8 pm stood W by E  
and at 4 am stood W by E at 11 am saw  
a finback breaching Lat by obs 30° 12' South  
Long by Lardner 78° 52' West  
variation 1 Point East by



# Bound to the Northward Coast of Chili

Remarks on Board Wednesday December 28 1836  
151 First and middle part brisk winds from the North  
stood W by E at 4 pm stood W by E at 5 am stood  
W by E latter part moderate saw a finback  
So ends Lat by obs 28° 24' South  
Long by Lardner 74° 54' West

Remarks on Board Thursday December 29 1836  
152 all the 24 hours moderate winds from the North  
stood W by E at 4 pm stood W by E at 5 am stood  
W by E employed in ship's duty  
Saw Kitties and Kelp variation 1 Point East by  
So ends Lat by obs 27° 22' South  
Long by Lardner 73° 50' West

Remarks on Board Friday December 30 1836  
153 First and middle part fine winds from the North  
stood W by E at 4 pm stood W by E at 5 am stood  
W by E latter part light winds from the North  
the East saw black fish and heard for the  
first time at 11 am on board finbacks  
Lat by obs 26° 11' South  
Long by Lardner 73° 15' West

Remarks on Board Saturday December 31 1836  
154 The 24 hours moderate winds from the North  
stood W by E at 4 pm stood W by E at 4 am stood  
W by E at 5 am saw a large sperm whale yawning  
back to the S by E heard for the first time at 10 pm  
up the shore so on board saw black fish  
and got 9 Kitties variation 1 Point East by  
Lat by obs 24° 50' South  
Long by Lardner 73° 00' West
