162 First Port Light Wind from the SE lower WNW at 1 Am Saw Whales Breaching 8 miles off to the East Land at 6 Struck one at daylight Back him along Side at 4 Am heard the main land alive Bearing WNW 40 miles distant at daylight commenced cutting at 9 finished at 11 began to boil Lat by obs 16.40 South

163 This 24 hours Employed in Boiling Middle Port Moderate Wind from the SE Stead WNW at 4 am Stead WNW the land in sight at 12 Am finished Boiling So End
