Remarks on Board Friday January 20 1837
174 First Port moderate winds from the SE
Course worth at 4 pm took on the Popocatepetl
Sails and stood west. Saw a bridge throwing
out at 8 am stood north saw four backs
Lat by obs 12° 29' South
Long by obs 79° 31' West

Remarks on Board Saturday January 21 1837
175 This 24 hours fine weather stood north at 4 pm
stood west at 8 am stood NW So ends
Lat by obs 11° 35' South
Long by obs 80° 13' West

Remarks on Board Sunday January 22 1837
176 First Port stood NE by E at 4 pm lay two
at daylight hauled sail and stood W by W
Lat by obs 10° 20' South
Long by obs 80° 20' West

Remarks on Board Monday January 23 1837
177 This 24 hours much the same Employed in painting
Saw Black fish two obs this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday January 24 1837
178 This day moderate weather stood north and
lay two for the night Employed in painting
Saw Black fish Lat by obs 9° 15' South
Long by obs 80° 53' West

Remarks on Board Wednesday January 25 1837
179 all the 24 hours moderate winds from the
SE stood north at 4 pm lay two heading out
at day light saw Black fish four for the same
at 4 am stood NW Employed in painting
Lat by obs 8° 38' South
Long by obs 81° 30' West

Remarks on Board Thursday January 26 1837
180 This day and 24 hours moderate winds
from the SE stood north by two for the
night Employed in painting So ends
Lat by obs 7° 48' South
Long by obs 81° 36' West

Remarks on Board Friday January 27 1837
181 all the 24 hours light air and calm
heading to the NW saw a number of
Sharks and Sun squalls So ends
Lat by obs 7° 21' South
Long by obs 81° 27' West

Remarks on Board Saturday January 28 1837
182 First Port moderate winds from the SE stood NE
with all sail set at 6 pm hauled sail
and stood north at 4 am hauled all sail with
light air and calm at daylight hauled the
Island of Salas y Terras bearing NE distant
14 miles long of the land 80° 46' long by obs
land 10 miles of ~~land~~ bearing east 80° 52' West
Lat by obs 6° 27' South
at 9 am hauled Point de Reyes bearing
NW distant 26 miles
at 8 am sent the Boat
on shore at 12 pm returned with cages to end

Remarks on Board Sunday January 29 1837
183 First Port moderate winds from the SE
stood NE at 8 pm Point de Reyes bore
NE latter part light air and calm
at 6 am hauled Point de Reyes bearing NE
distant 26 miles Lat by obs 5° 24' South
