fitting the boats Sat by obs 8 1/2 at back
Long by log 82 1/2 05 West

Remarks on Board Thursday February 9 1837

all this 24 hours moderate wind Stead
West at 6 PM shortened sail at daylight
Sail and Stead West Sat by obs 8 1/2 05 West
Long by account 83 1/2 05 West

Remarks on Board Friday February 10 1837

First Port calm latter I saw black birds
from the East Stead SW saw black birds
going back to the windward to end
Sat by obs 8 1/2 26 South
Long by log 83 1/2 32 West

Remarks on Board Saturday February 11 1837

First Port moderate winds from the East
Stead West by 8 1/2 middle Port lay on back
at daylight Stead West at 6 am board
for black fish at 11 am on board at 12 PM
Shook a Sandwich Island Sealer from
Payta Sat by obs 8 1/2 08 South
Long by log 84 1/2 26 West

Remarks on Board Sunday February 12 1837

all this 24 hours moderate winds from the East
Stead West at 6 PM Stead West by 8 1/2 at 6 am
Stead West saw black fish and board for
the same saw a Seal Steady West
Sat by obs 4 1/2 42 South
Long by log 85 1/2 22 West
Long by hand obs 85 1/2 19 West
