Remarks on Board Friday February 17, 1837
First Part calm middle Part brisk wind
from the W. E heading S. E by E with the main
sloop to the mast latter Part calm
Employed in painting the foreland boat
Lat by obs 20 54 South
Long by obs 86 46 West

Remarks on Board Saturday February 18, 1837
First and middle Part calm latter
Part light wind from S. E accompanied with
brisk showers of rain Saw two ships
standing to the westward

all the 24 hours fine wind from the S. E
stood at 6 Pm lay two at day light
had all sail and stood at the anchor
Boiling Black fish Lat by obs 10 59 South
Long by obs 87 14 49 West

Remarks on Board Tuesday February 21, 1837
First Part fine wind from the S. E. stood
at 6 Pm lay two at day light stood
at 11 and made all sail Lat by obs 14 23 South

Remarks on Board Wednesday February 22, 1837
First Part stood at 3 Pm saw Black
fish saw one at 6 Pm took in the
top of sails and stood by 11 by 11 at 4 am
stood at 11 and made all sail at 6 am
saw Chatham Island bearing S. by W. distant
20 miles at 7 stood West at 11 am saw
Hood Island bearing S. by W. at 11 saw bearing
Island bearing West Lat by obs 10 54 South
South land bearing E by S distant
Remarks on Board Thursday February 23, 1837
at 1 Pm got a distant sight of the
Long 89 51 East Chatham bearing East distant
19 miles at 3 Pm saw Black fish stood
by 11 by 11 at 3 saw Porters Island bearing
at 11 by 11 at 4 am stood at 11
at 6 made James Island bearing N by E
stood West at 10 am the boats went on
shore So End.
