S by S San Francisco Lat by obs 33° 33' North
Long by obs 84° 19' West

Remarks on Board Wednesday March 8 1837
This 24 hours light wind from the SE
Stead by S by S Employed in blowing down
oil 128 main hole so and Lat by obs 24° 44' North
Long by obs 101° 11' West

Remarks on Board Thursday March 9 1837
First middle Port calm latter Port brisk
Showers of rain Even obs this day

Remarks on Board Friday March 10 1837
First and middle Port fire wind from
the SSE Stead by S by S latter Port moderate
Lat by obs 31° 20' South
Long by obs 97° 00' West

Remarks on Board Saturday March 11 1837
First and middle Port strong wind from the
SSE Stead by S by S San Francisco at 6 pm
double reef the sails latter Port more
moderate Lat by obs 31° 18' South
Long by obs 98° 20' West

Remarks on Board Sunday March 12 1837
all the 24 hours moderate wind from the
SE Stead by S at 6 pm Stead West latter
Port the same Lat by obs 31° 49' South
Long by obs 100° 24' West

Remarks on Board Monday March 13 1837
This 24 hours fire with Stead West at sunset
shortened sail and Stead by SSE at midnight
shortened lat at daylight Stead by S
Lat by obs 41° 06' South
Long by obs 101° 39' West
Long by Lunar obs 101° 08' West

Remarks on Board Tuesday March 14 1837
First Port Stead by S at 9 pm San Hillin
Dickinson a ship standing to the SW at 6 am
Stead by S Lat by obs 41° 14' South
Long by obs 103° 11' West

Remarks on Board Wednesday March 15 1837
First Port Stead by S at 2 pm San a ship
middle Port Squally with rain heading south
latter Port heavy Even obs this day

Remarks on Board Thursday March 16 1837
First Port Brisk wind from the East Stead South
at 4 pm Shook the ship Hoops of iron Bedford
16 mountain 700 at 6 am Stead by S with
all drawing sail set So Ends
Lat by obs 31° 12' South
Long by obs 108° 16' West
