First and Middle Part of day Employed
in getting Ready for sea at daylight got under
way and Stead to by 12 at noon barometer
went down bore 108 distant 8 miles so ends
Lat by obs 21.06 North
at 11 am saw Nochoo bearing West 10.

Remarks on Board Monday May 22. 1837
at 1 Pm Stead to wind with strong trade
at 2 Pm got a altitude for the lat Long
188.39 West at 6 Pm Nochoo North Part
Bore it by 20 Stead North with double
reef. Deprais on bent the collar and stowed
anchors at 6 Pm double reef the Deprais
at daylight Mard sail Employed in ship duty
Lat by obs 22.28 North
Long by obs 188.14 West

Remarks on Board Tuesday May 23. 1837
First Part fine wind from the E by E
Stead by North at 6 Pm shortened sail
Satter Part Bore wind Employed in
Ship duty So Ends. Done also this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 24. 1837
all the 24 hours fine weather Stead by obs 27
at 6 Pm shortened sail. at daylight Mard
sail So Ends. Lat by obs 25.00 North
Long by obs 188.38 West

Remarks on Board Thursday May 25. 1837
all the 24 hours fine weather Stead by obs 26
Employed in setting up shoocks So Ends.
Lat by obs 26.28 North
Long by obs 188.51 West

all the 24 hours moderate winds from
the ENE Stead by obs 27.24 North
Painting the boats so Ends.
Lat by obs 27.24 North
Long by obs 189.01 West

Remarks on Board Saturday May 27 1837
This day light air and calm heading to the
North Employed in ship duty So Ends.
Lat by obs 27.34 North
Long by obs 188.50 West

Remarks on Board Sunday May 28. 1837
all the 24 hours light air and fine weather
at 1 Pm saw Spinn Whale. Board for the swim
at 7 am on board at 6 am saw Whale
Board got 6 got the ship at noon
Went also this day

Remarks on Board Monday May 29. 1837
First Part Employed in cutting at 4 got the
Mach and commenced boiling at 4 am
Employed in cutting and boiling at 10 am
finished cutting with fine weather so ends
Lat by obs 27.39 North

Remarks on Board Tuesday May 30. 1837
The 24 hours fine weather Employed in
Boiling So Ends. Done also this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 31 1837
all the 24 moderate winds from the S E
Stead by obs 28 Employed in boiling at 6 Pm
where ship to the ENE Satter Part much the
sail at noon finished boiling So Ends.
Lat by obs 28.21 North
Long by obs 188.35 West
