Remarks on Board Thursday June 15 1839
First Part moderate winds from the East
Steered SSW at 1 Pm Shortened sail and
steered by WNW wind W.C. by 8 Latter Part
Employed in stowing ore in the hold
Lat By obs 31° 43' North
Long By Lat 168° 13' West

Remarks on Board Friday June 16 1839
First Part brisk winds from the W.C. by 4
steered by WNW at 3 Pm where ship to the S.W. 40
at 4 Pm took in the fore and main sheets
at 5 am made sail and steered S.W. Employed
in Ship's duty So Ends
Lat By obs 30° 44' North
Long By Lat 167° 50' West

The 14 hour light winds from the S.W. Steered
W.C. at 8 am Steered North So Ends
Lat By obs 31° 40' North
Long By Lat 167° 00' West

Remarks on Board Monday June 19 1839
all the day fine weather Steered by W.S.W.
Employed in Repairing broken Sails So Ends
Lat By obs 31° 33' North
Long By Lat 168° 06' West

Remarks on Board Tuesday June 20 1839
The 24 hour fine winds from the S.W. Steered by
S.W. by 8 Employed in Ship's duty So Ends
Lat By obs 31° 01' North
Long By Lat 167° 27' West

Remarks on Board Wednesday June 21 1839
First Part light winds from the S.W. Steered
by S.W. by 8 Latter Part light air and calm
heading South Lat By obs 30° 01' North
Long By Lat 167° 14' West

Remarks on Board Thursday June 22 1839
First and middle Part calm
Latter Part brisk winds from the
S.W. Steered by W.C. by 8 accompanied
with brisk showers of rain
So Ends
