Remarks on Board Monday July 3 1837

First Port Steers S.W. at 7 Pm by two
at 8 am Steers West with strong wind
at 6 saw whale at 7 found at 9 struck
at 10 took him along side getting ready
for cutting so Endeavour on the way

Remarks on Board Tuesday July 4 1837

First Port Employed in cutting at 7 Pm
Finished at midnight Began to haul
at 6 am hauled Seal and Saw bullocks
Steers by S.W. by S.W. So Endeavour
Lat by obs 30° 18' North
Long by obs 146° 08' West

Remarks on Board Wednesday July 5 1837

Shes 24 hours fine weather Employed
in Boiling so Endeavour Lat by obs 30° 28' North
Long by obs 146° 28' West

Remarks on Board Thursday July 6 1837

This day light air and calm at 4 Pm finished
boiling Sutter Port Employed in ship duty
so Endeavour Lat by obs 30° 28' North
Long by obs 146° 38' West

Remarks on Board Friday July 7 1837

Shes 24 hours light air from the S.W. Steers
by S.W. by S.W. Employed in stowing oil in
the main hold so Endeavour on the way

Remarks on Board Saturday July 8 1837

First and middle Port calm at midnight
Saw a large sperm whale along side at 11 am
found two boats for the sperm at daylight
Saw more the boat in chase at 11 am struck
and posted the line with moderate winds
from the west whale going back to the
East so Endeavour on the way

Cruising on the meridian in 1837

Remarks on Board Sunday July 9 1837

First Port in chase of the before
mentioned whale at 1 Pm struck and
found at 7 Pm on board middle
Port calm Sutter Port light air from the
South Steers by S.W. by S.W. So Endeavour
Lat by obs 30° 31' North
Long by obs 146° 38' West

Long by Lunar obs 146° 02' West

Remarks on Board Monday July 10 1837

Shes 24 hours light air from the South
Steers West Employed in ship duty so Endeavour
Lat by obs 30° 31' North
Long by obs 146° 48' West

Long by Lunar obs 146° 14' West

Remarks on Board Tuesday July 11 1837

Shes 24 hours moderate wind from the S.W. &
Steers by S.W. by S.W. Employed in ship duty
at 11 am Saw sperm whale 5 miles off
so Endeavour on the way

Remarks on Board Wednesday July 12 1837

at noon found for the before mentioned
whale at 3 Pm struck at 8 took him
along side the boat in chase of more
at 4 am on board and set the watch for
the night at daylight commenced cutting
with brisk wind on the way

Remarks on Board Thursday July 13 1837

at 2 Pm finished cutting the before
mentioned whale at 4 began to haul
Sutter Port brisk wind from the S.W.
Steers by S.W. by S.W. So Endeavour
Lat by obs 30° 56' North
Long by obs 146° 40' West
