Remarks on Board Friday July 14 1839
The 24 hours Employed in Boiling at Daylight
Saw wharls, going back to the windward side
For the steam at 4 am on Board at 11 am
Finished Boiling So Ends
Lat By obs 30.55 North

Remarks on Board Saturday July 15 1839
at noon saw wharls, took at 1 struck
40 lbs at 3 took him along side 2 boats in
shore at 4 struck and sent the fire
at 4 am on Board and set the watch
with a large ft swell from the N.E.
at daylight began to cut at 9 am finished
So Ends even on this day

Remarks on Board Sunday July 16 1839
all the 24 hours Employed in Boiling
heading to the N.E. latter part Employed in
sawing of the main hole 43 lbs So Ends
Even on this day

Remarks on Board Monday July 17 1839
The 24 hours brack winds from the S.W.
Stead by C.E. at 4 Pm finished Boiling
latter part Employed in cooping oil so ends
Lat By obs 31.40 North
Long by obs 146.36 West

Remarks on Board Tuesday July 18 1839
First and middle part brack winds from
the S.E. Stead by C.E. at 9 am there
shift to the N.W. Employed in sawing
oil 63 lbs in the four hole So Ends
204
Even on this day

Cruising in the Long of 179 West

Remarks on Board Wednesday July 19 1839
First part brack winds from the S.W. Stead
by N.E. at 3 Pm where shift to the E.S.E.
at daylight made all sail saw a lark
So Ends
Lat By obs 31.12 North
Long by obs 148.57 West

Remarks on Board Thursday July 20 1839
First part brack winds from the S.W.
Stead by S.E. by E at 4 Pm saw wharls
40 lbs board and struck got to the ship at
8 at daylight commenced cutting with
40 lbs fine weather at noon finished cutting
So Ends even on this day

Remarks on Board Friday July 21 1839
all the 24 hours fine weather Employed
in Boiling So Ends Lat By obs 31.22 North
Long by obs 148.35 West

Remarks on Board Saturday July 22 1839
This day fine weather and variable winds.
Employed in Boiling at noon finished
So Ends
Lat By obs 31.12 North
Long by obs

Remarks on Board Sunday July 23 1839
First and middle part light winds and variable
latter part S.W. saw a lark
So Ends even on this day

Remarks on Board Monday July 24 1839
The 24 hours squally accompanied with rain
and variable winds.
So Ends
Even on this day
