 60 Mts took him along side at day light &
 commenced cutting with brisk winds and
 a large sea so Ende covered the day
 Long by account 146.40 West

Remarks on Board Friday August 18. 1837
 at 2 pm finished cutting the before
 mentioned whale at 3 began to boil
 heading W & E by 1 at 6 saw a sail talked
 Part Strong Gale with Brisk Showers
 of Rain at 8 am where ship to the
 Snd So Ends. Lat by obs 30.53 North
 Long by account 147.00 West

Remarks on Board Saturday August 19. 1837
 First and middle Part Brisk winds from the
 SE Stood by S & E by 1 at 3 pm where ship to
 the W & E Employed in Boiling at 1 am where
 ship to the Snd by 1 at 4 am finished Boiling
 and made sail 2 sail in sight So Ends
 Lat by obs 31.01 North
 Long by account 147.10 West

Remarks on Board Sunday August 20. 1837
 The 24 hours moderate winds from the East
 Stood by South at 4 pm spoke the ship George
 of New Bedford at 8 am took ship to the
 W & E 3 sail in sight So Ends
 Lat by obs 31.08 North
 Long by account 147.30 West

 The 24 hours fresh winds from the East Stood
 by S & E 3 sail in sight at 8 am where ship to
 the W & E Employed in stowing oil 18 in the
 Fore hold & Ends. Lat by obs 30.49 North
 Long by account 147.25 West

Remarks on Board Tuesday August 22. 1837
 The 24 hours fresh the same Stood by S & E
 at 8 am took ship to the W & E So Ends
 Lat by obs 30.24 North
 Long by account 147.20 West

Remarks on Board Wednesday August 23. 1837
 First Part Brisk winds from the E & S Stood
 by W & E at 8 am took ship to the South
 3 sail in sight So Ends. Lat by obs 30.53 North
 Long by account 147.00 West
 Long by Sun obs 147.37 West

Remarks on Board Thursday August 24. 1837
 The 24 hours strong winds from the W & E Stood
 by E & W with dull weather 4 sail in sight So Ends
 Lat by obs 31.25 North
 Long by account 146.20 West
 Long by Sun obs 146.58 West

Remarks on Board Friday August 25. 1837
 First Part fine weather Stood by E & W latter part
 strong winds and squally 4 sail in sight saw
 whale to the Windward So Ends. Lat by obs 31.42 North
 Long by account 146.12 West

Remarks on Board Saturday August 26 1837
 First Part moderate winds from the South Stood
 by E & S at 2 pm saw whale saved for the
 Saim at 4 am on Board spoke the ship George
 of Nantucket 900 bbls latter Part Employed
 in setting up Rigging one sail in sight So Ends
 Lat by obs 31.40 North
 Long by Sun obs 145.52 West
 Long by account 145.30 West
