Bore East distant 8 miles and stood by
death with all sail set at midnight

in ship's duty So Ends Sat by Oct 22. 29. 29
long by lot 153. 09 west

Remarks on Board Friday November 3. 1833
First Port fine winds from the E by S
stood by with at midnight double reef
the Japans heading W & by of latter Port
strong gale and raining at 10 am short
sailed the Japans So Ends Sat by Oct 23. 54 west
long by lot 156. 16 west

Remarks on Board Saturday November 4. 1833
This 24 hours strong gale from the SE
stood by with about reef to sail
Sat by Oct 24. 33 west
long by lot 158. 19 west

Remarks on Board Sunday November 5. 1833
all the day strong trade stood by with
with double reef Japans So Ends Sat by Oct 25. 41 west
long by lot 154. 50 west
