Remarks on Board Tuesday April 16 1838

First Port Brisk wind from the W by S Stead by

Peter Peterson returned to his duty. at 6 Pm ~~Remarks~~
Carp returned to his duty. Sailed Port Strong Gale.
Lost reef the ~~Remarks~~ with a long head. So sent
down the four and seven J. of mast and yard.
So End. Sat By obs 24. 24 altitude

First and middle Port Strong Gale from the
W by S Stead By night with double reef. ~~Remarks~~
at 6 Pm saw a sail on the sea. ~~Remarks~~ Sailed Port
more moderate. So the main lower. So End.

in Repairing Sails and Painting the Starboard Boat
So End. Sat By obs 27. 18 altitude
Long By Chron Tide 161. 28 West

Remarks on Board Saturday April 21 1838

This 24 hours fine wind from the East Stead
North and West Employed in Painting the West
Boat and other evening jobs. Sat By obs 28. 21 altitude
Long By Chron Tide 162. 15 West

Remarks on Board Sunday April 22 1838

This day the same Stead W by S with all
sailing. Sailed Port So End. Sat By obs 28. 41 altitude
Long By Chron Tide 163. 36 West

Remarks on Board Monday April 23 1838

All this 24 hours fine weather Stead West
Employed in changing the fore and main topmasts.
Saw fine look. So End. Sat By obs 28. 52 altitude
Long By Chron Tide 165. 00 West

Remarks on Board Tuesday April 24 1838

First Port light wind from the E by S. ~~Remarks~~
Sailed Port ~~Remarks~~ from the S by S Stead by
W by S with all sail set. Sat By obs 29. 15 altitude
Long By Chron Tide 166. 04 West

Remarks on Board Wednesday April 25 1838

This 24 hours moderate wind from the S by S
Stead by West. Sailed Port haze. So End.
Sun obscure
