First and middle Port fine weather Stead went  
at 4 am Stead went saw finbacks and porpoise  
but lost Rainy. Sun obscure

Remarks on Board Friday May 25. 1838  
First and middle Port Squally latter Port  
Strong Breeze at 10 AM at 8 am saw  
whale going to the N.W. 13.5 found but  
the rain but being not cold water found  
was on this day

Remarks on Board Saturday May 26. 1838  
First Port in Chase of the before mentioned  
whale at 2 PM came on board at 4 PM

Saw a whale on the sea down town at 6  
80 lbs. struck at 9 took him along side at daylight  
began to cut with a large saw

Remarks on Board Sunday May 27. 1838  
at 9 PM finished cutting at 4 began to bat  
with light air and calm

fat by oh 28.54 cwt. East  
long by thro tide 176.12 East

Remarks on Board Monday May 28. 1838  
all the 24 hours light air and calm Employed  
in working saw breches supposed to be whale  
go fat to land at 6 am finished butling at 9 am

Saw a school of whale found for the team  
No End.

Remarks on Board Tuesday May 29. 1838  
First Port in Chase of the before mentioned whale  
at 8 PM got up the chase got to the ship at 4 PM  
middle and latter Port light air and calm  
Employed in working oil 1360 lbs. found hole  
No End

long by thro tide 176.18 East

all the 24 hours fine weather light air and calm  
heading NW Employed in ship duty No End  
fat by oh 29.02 cwt. East

Remarks on Board Thursday May 31. 1838  
First Port light air and calm Middle Port  
Squally with rain heading NW fat Port Breches  
found at 10 PM Stead South Employed in ship  
duty No End. fat by oh 28.53 cwt. East

Remarks on Board Friday June 1. 1838  
all the day fresh breeze at 10 PM Stead South  
at 4 PM shortened sail and head ship to the water  
at 8 am head sail and Stead went saw finbacks  
fat by oh 29.05 cwt. East

Remarks on Board Saturday June 2. 1838  
all the day fresh breeze at 10 PM Stead South  
at 4 PM two at 8 hours Stead went saw 3 whales  
Shook the young Eagle of about 23 months out  
990 lbs. fat by oh 30.21 cwt. East

Remarks on Board Sunday June 3. 1838  
all the day fine weather Stead went  
middle Port fat by saw finbacks No End.  
fat by oh 31.38 cwt. East

Remarks on Board Monday June 4. 1838  
First and middle Port Stead 5.58 fat Port 1.58  
with fine weather one whale in sight No End.  
fat by oh 31.02 cwt. East

Remarks on Board Tuesday June 5. 1838  
at noon Shook the whale Lebberson of about 23  
22 months out 1300 Stead South in company  
middle Port fat by latter Port Stead South  
fat by oh 30.08 cwt. East
