Remarks on Board Friday September 28 1838

First part stand by SSE one sail in sight
at pm heard ship to the westward lat part squally

with rain at 3 am lat the four topgallant and bent
a clothes lat by obs 28. 16 north

Long by Chro did. 159. 35 west

Remarks on Board Saturday September 29 1838

This 24 hours fine winds at S by S stand by
at 8 sent up the four topgallant mast and yard

lat by obs 29. 00 north

First part light winds at East stand by S
at midnight winds heard to the S by S stand

by S by S lat part winds at 10 am S by S
