land Bearing West distant 10 miles

Stead SSW

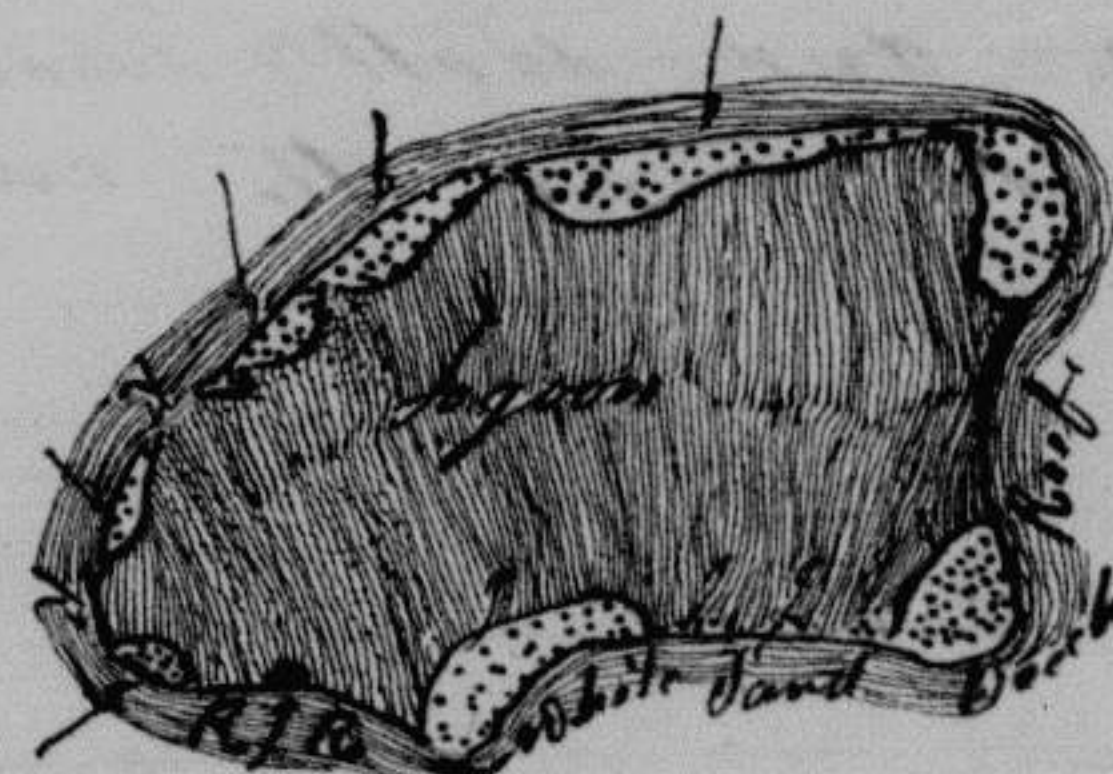

Remarks on Board Sunday January 27 1839
First Part fine wind at 10 by SSW
by 6 1/2 with all sail set at 2 pm heard
Duke of Clarence's Island Bearing SSE
distant 20 miles at 6 pm it bore west
distant 2 miles Shortened sail and headed
to the north at 1 am heard ship to the SSW
with moderate wind at 10 am at 6 am
the land was 18 miles distant at 10 am
it bore SSW distant 10 miles from the
center
