 First Part Squally winds at Wed Stead
 by S.W. by N at 4 P.m. Stead East
 at 6 P.m. lost sight of the land bearing
 N.W. distant 12 miles at 8 P.m. by by
 and calm at 6 am Saw D. Wolf's Island
 bearing E by S distant 15 miles bearing
 at 10 am Saw the craters on shore from
 the mast head at 1100 it bore W by
 S 8 miles
 Lat by obs 9.26 North
 Long of the land 141.07 West

This Island was discovered
 in 1838 on the 14 day of
 February and called
 D. Wolf's Island



This low and well wooded I have
 landed and found the craters friendly

Remarks on Board Tuesday January 29, 1839
 First Part Stead. Wind at Ship Steady off
 and on at D. Wolf's Island at 2 P.m. went
 on shore got some coconuts and found
 the craters friendly at 4 P.m. returned
 and Stead S.E. at 9 by a fresh breeze
 B.C.B. at 6 am Stead S by E. S. by S
 Lat by obs 10.07 South
 Long by obs 140.29 West

Remarks on Board Wednesday January 30, 1839
 At the day strong gale from the west by N
 and squally with much showers of rain
 Stead S by E. by S. Port by by heading
 at 8 by at midnight went to the west
 at 6 am Stead S by E. with clouds and
 squalls
 Lat by obs 11.20 South
 Long by obs 140.33 West

Remarks on Board Thursday January 31, 1839
 First Part Stead S by E. by S. Port by
 by heading with wind N.W. at 6 am
 Stead South with squally weather and a
 surge sea
 Lat by obs 12.22 South
 Long by obs 140.35 West

Remarks on Board Friday February 1, 1839
 First Part Wind at 1100 Stead S by E
 with clouds and squalls. Middle and last
 Part winds E by S Stead South with fresh
 winds
 Lat by obs 13.18 South
 Long by obs 140.26 West

Remarks on Board Saturday February 2, 1839
 First Part Stead South with E by S and
 squally with Port by by heading at 3 P.m.
 about 1000 miles bearing S by E distant 35 miles
 West Point at 4 P.m. Saw Oahook bearing
 N by E distant 20 miles Stead S by E at 6 am
 heard ship to the W by W with strong gale
 at noon saw the West Point of Oahook
 bearing E by E distant 12 miles Lat by obs 14.38 South
 Long by obs 140.26 West
