North at 8 pm began to drift and heard
to the South at 6 am saw that two of
the four topmast Shrouds were parted
at 8 heard ship to the North

to the SSE at midnight heard to the North
at 4 am saw a large wharve joining quick
to the windward board with out Shrouds at
11 am saw on board Sat by obs 00.01 in South

first Port Stead by W by at 6 pm Stead by SSE
at midnight heard to the W by at 6 am heard to

first Port Stead by SSE with strong winds
