gust, with the wind with strong winds and
long sea

3 Remarks on Board Monday August 9 1839

all this day fine winds at West lower part with
all drawing sail got employed in fitting the boats
Bar-tide 1 Point East July Lat by obs 34.56 South
Long by this tide 178.48 East

4 Remarks on Board Tuesday August 6 1839

Tide and middle part strong West Stead 64° with
all sail set at 1 am wind heard to the West
Stead 64° employed in ship's duty No land
Lat by obs 35.14 South
Long by this tide 179.16 West

5 Remarks on Board Wednesday August 7 1839

Tide and middle part fine winds at 11.30
Stead 64° at 2 am wind heard to the West
Stead 6° with all sail set employed in ship's duty
Lat by obs 35.20 South
Long by this tide 176.40 West

6 Remarks on Board Thursday August 8 1839

Tide and middle part strong West Stead 64°
last part strong at 11.30 with all drawing sail
set employed in ship's duty Bar-tide 1 Point
East No land
Lat by obs 35.30 South
Long by this tide 174.43 West
