This day strong gale at 8 o'clock with rain

Remarks on Board Thursday August 1 1839
This day strong gale at 8 o'clock and 8 o'clock with
a large swell setting in to the Bay 10 o'clock

Remarks on Board Friday August 2 1839
First and middle part strong winds at 8 o'clock
at 8 am got under way from our anchor
and put to sea with fine wind at 8 o'clock and
steamed out of the Bay at 10 35 22 1/2 got a altitude
port the Chronometer July 174 15 East
Cape Brett Bearing 68 1/2 Distance 8 miles at 11 am
Quell off the Mount with strong winds and a
large sea

1 This day strong gale at 8 o'clock Stead 10 o'clock
with West wind 10 o'clock and a large sea
at 6 pm sent sight of Cape Brett Bearing 8 1/2
Distance 30 miles sent Port calm with change
10 o'clock

Remarks on Board Sunday August 4 1839
2 sent Port calm at 6 pm took a breeze at 10 o'clock with
Rain began sent at 11 pm wind began to the West
sent Port Head at 12 am sent the Towel 10 o'clock
steaming sent and had steaming sent with fine wind
10 o'clock 34 1/2 South
Long by this time 174 27 East

Remarks on Board Monday August 5 1839
3 all this day fine winds at west from east with
all drawing sail sent employed in filling the Boats
10 o'clock 1 Point 10 o'clock sent 34 1/2 South
Long by this time 175 48 East

Remarks on Board Tuesday August 6 1839
4 sent and middle part strong winds West Stead 10 o'clock with
all sail sent at 1 am winds began to the West
Stead 10 o'clock employed in ship duty 10 o'clock
10 o'clock 35 1/4 South
Long by this time 179 16 West

Remarks on Board Wednesday August 7 1839
5 sent and middle part fine winds at West
Stead 10 o'clock at 2 am winds began to the West
Stead 10 o'clock with all sail sent employed in ship duty
10 o'clock 35 20 South
Long by this time 186 40 West

Remarks on Board Thursday August 8 1839
6 sent and middle part strong winds West Stead 10 o'clock
sent Port Head at 10 o'clock with all drawing sail
sent employed in ship duty 10 o'clock 1 Point
10 o'clock 35 30 South
Long by this time 174 43 West
