Sat 5:30 N. Long 5:10 W. Clear weather all this
day with light breeze from N. The ship started for
the wind and on different tack during the day
Spoke bark Catalpa. The watch employed in
boiling and so ends a number of sails in sight

Tuesday August 24th
No Ob^r + Clear weather all this day
with light breeze from N. The ship started for
the wind and on different tack during the day
Spoke bark Catalpa. The watch employed in
boiling and so ends a number of sails in sight

Wednesday August 25th
Sat 5:30 N. Long 5:10 W. Boiling until 3 P.M.
Clear weather the remainder of the day spoke
bark Catalpa. The ship heading to S. E. by
the wind with a light breeze from E. The
latter part saw bark Catalpa chasing
a whale lowered and mated and got the
whale got him alongside and got ready
to cut it.

Thursday August 26th
No Ob^r + Calm all this day all hands
employed in cutting up. The Catalpa in company
with some of her men on board helping cut and
so ends

Friday August 27th
No Ob^r + Calm all this day all hands
employed in cutting up and boiling. Spoke bark
Catalpa. The ship heading to S. E. and so ends.

Saturday August 28th
No Ob^r + Clear weather all this day with a
salon the first and middle parts. The latter parts
light breeze from S. W. The ship heading to S. E.
All hands employed in boiling and taking
care of oil several sails in sight and so ends

Sunday August 29th
Sat 5:30 N. Long 5:10 W. Clear weather
all this day with light breeze from N. The
ship heading to N. E. The first part 3 sails
in sight one cutting one boiling. The middle
and latter parts the ship heading to S. E.
by the wind all hands employed in boiling
and clearing up and so ends

Monday August 30th
Sat 5:30 N. Long 5:10 W. The first of this
day clear weather and a fresh breeze from N. W. The
ship heading to S. E. by the wind under easy sail
finished boiling at 3 P.M. turned up 1000 lbs
Spoke bark Catalpa boiling the middle
part and latter strong breeze from S. E. and
with a few rain squalls ship heading to S.
and so ends

Tuesday August 31st
Sat 5:30 N. Long 5:10 W. Clear weather
all this day with rain squalls. The ship started
for the wind with a fresh breeze from N. W.
The ship heading to S. E. The first and
middle parts at 4 P.M. saw bark Catalpa
going to N. E. lowered the boat to S. of the
mast boat went on and the boat started
did not strike him with a good chance of
the remainder of the day

Wednesday September 1st
No Ob^r + Clear weather all this day with rain squalls all the
day. The bark down until 3 P.M. chasing the whale mated with bark
Catalpa. The ship heading to S. E. and so ends.
