Tuesday September 14th
Lat 33° 50' N Long 86° 46' W Clear weather
The first part with light breeze from N. by E. The
ship heading to N. by E. The middle part breeze
with fresh breeze from N. by E. to N. E. headed
the fore top sail. The latter part moderate gale
from N. by E. no ship and none to heading to
N. by E. under fore sail and full reefed main
top sail One sail in sight and no ends.

Wednesday September 15th
No Ob. Moderate gales from N. by E. to N. E.
The ship hove to heading from N. to N. E. and
two sails some rain in the latter part and no
ends.

Thursday September 16th
No Ob. Moderate gales from N. by E. The first
and middle parts with rain. The ship hove to

gales from N. ship hove to all day heading to N.
Barometer 29.5 at the close of the day.

Thursday September 23rd
Lat 33° 50' N Long 86° 18' W Clear weather the
first and middle parts with a strong breeze
N. by E. heading to N. under easy sail.
The latter part overcast. Ship heading
to N. by E. under fore top sail and no ends.

Friday September 24th
No Ob. Clear weather most of this day with light
breeze from N. by E. to N. E. heading to N. by E. The middle part
calm. The latter part light breeze from N. by E. to N. E. and no ends.
