

Sunday November 21st
Lat 9 30 N Long 22 56 W At 10 AM weather
This day light breeze from different quarters with
calms and rain squalls Course S. The ship heaving
to S. and most of the time

Monday November 22nd
Squally and rainy with variable winds and
calms Course S and so ends

Tuesday November 23rd
No Ob. Squally and rainy with light
variable winds and calms the first part the ship
heading in all directions course S the middle
part overcast with light breeze from the ship
heading to W. N. W. the latter part the wind fresh
to W. S. W. the ship heading from S. to S. W. the
remainder of the day and so ends

Wednesday November 24th
No Ob. Clear weather most of the day with
very light airs from N. E. S. the first and middle parts
Course S all sail set one sail in sight the latter part
calm and so ends

Thursday November 25th
Lat 10 00 N Long 21 11 W Fine weather all
this day with light airs from N. E. S. Course S
M. A. drawing sails set. One sail in sight
and so ends

Friday November 26th
No Ob. Clear weather the first part with
very light airs N. E. S. Course S. The middle part
squally and rainy the ship heading to S. E. W.
the latter part light airs from S. E. Course S
plenty of black fish around lowered for them
but could not get on. At 11 A. M. Spent sperm whale
got to O. M. lowered the boats and the L. B.
struck and then lost sight of the whales in
a heavy rain squall and so on board
clearing hard and so ends

Saturday November 27th
No Ob. Squally all this day with rain
At 5 A. M. San. sperm whale lowered the last
boats the boat lowered boat came down and got to
O. M. the boat struck S. E. S. got the whale
by the mast and at 10 the S. struck a large whale
the first officer of the S. in shooting the whale
the gun burst shattering his hand and leg and
the whale and got them alongside and so ends

Sunday November 28th
No Ob. Squally and rainy all this day
with variable winds All hands employed in
cutting At 11 A. M. San. sperm whale lowered two
boats and the boat got a whale cutting all this
day and so ends

Monday November 29th
No Ob. Squally and rainy all this
day All hands employed in cutting and boiling
and so ends

Tuesday November 30th
No Ob. Squally and rainy all this day
The watch employed in boiling when the rain will
permit and so ends

Wednesday December 1st
Lat 10 38 N The first part heavy rain squalls
had to be blown The middle and latter parts less rain
Boiling when we can and so ends

Thursday December 2nd
No Ob. The first part light variable winds
working the ship to S. the middle part heavy rain
the latter part light airs and fine weather the
watch employed in taking care of oil and latelines
and so ends

Friday December 3rd
No Ob. Light air from southward with rain
squalls the watch employed in boiling the head
and taking care of oil and so ends
