

Sunday January 2nd
Lat 26° 4' Long 170° 10' W. The first part of the day strong breeze from S.E. The ship heading to E.N.W. with wind under double reefed topsails and fore sail. The middle more moderate made all sail ship heading to E by N. rain. The latter part fine weather with a breeze from N.E. Course S.E. and so on.

Monday January 3rd
Lat 25° 40' Long 162° 10' W. Fine weather all the day with light breeze from E.N.W. to N. Course S.E. All day the watch at work on shatz. The watch employed on the rigging and so on.

Tuesday January 4th
Lat 26° 08' Long 142° 24' W. Fine weather all the day with light breeze from N. Course S.E. Until 4 P.M. S.E. The remainder of the day. The watch employed on the rigging and so on.

Wednesday January 5th
Lat 26° 30' Long 122° 20' W. Fine weather all the day with light breeze from N. Course S.E. All day the watch employed on the rigging and so on.

Thursday January 6th
Lat 26° 25' Long 104° 10' W. Fine weather all the day with a light breeze from N. Course S.E. All day the watch employed on the rigging and so on.

Friday January 7th
Lat 26° 28' Long 86° 00' W. Fine weather all the day with light breeze from N. to N.E. Course S.E. The ship heading from N. to N.E. by E. And so on.

Saturday January 8th
Lat 26° 20' Long 68° 00' W. Fine weather all the day with light breeze from N. to N.E. Course S.E. The ship heading from N. to N.E. by E. The latter to N.W. by N. and so on.

Sunday January 9th
Lat 25° 40' Long 50° 00' W. Fine weather all the day with very light breeze from N.E. with calms. The ship heading from S. to S.E. by E. Most of the day.

Monday January 10th
Lat 25° 40' Long 34° 00' W. Clear weather all the day with a calm in the first part, the middle and latter part to light breeze from S.E. The ship heading to N.E. by N. The watch employed in ship's duty. In third officer at work repairing S.E. Boat and so on.

Tuesday January 11th
Lat 24° 15' Long 17° 20' W. Fine weather all the day with light breeze from S.E. The ship heading to N.E. by the wind and so on.

Wednesday January 12th
Lat 22° 20' Long 0° 00' W. Fine weather all the day with fresh breeze from S.E. The ship heading to N.E. The first part the middle part by S.E. The latter part course N.E. The watch employed in repairing a main top sail and so on.

Thursday January 13th
Lat 20° 20' Long 30° 00' W. Fine weather all the day with fresh breeze from S.E. Course N.E. All day the watch employed in repairing sails and so on.

Friday January 14th
Lat 18° 00' Long 60° 00' W. Fine weather all the day with fresh breeze from S.E. Course N. Until 7 P.M. The island of St. Helena in view in sight bearing N.W. by E 49 miles distant. The watch employed repairing sail and so on.

Saturday January 15th
Lat 16° 14' Long 89° 12' W. Breeze 4 miles to E. Fine weather all the day with light breeze from N. to N.E. The ship heading from N. to N.E. by E. The latter to N.W. by N. and so on.
