the eastward by the wind the captain on shore
The middle part off and on At 9 to 10 P.M.
Captain came off The ship heading to the
remainder of the day and so ends

Saturday January 22nd
Fine weather all this day with light
breezes from S. E. The ship stored by the wind
heading from S. to S. W. E. and so ends

Sunday January 23rd
No Ob^r Fine weather all this day with
light breezes from S. E. The ship heading to S. W. E.
by the wind all day all sail out and so ends

Monday January 24th
No Ob^r Fine weather all this day with light
trades The ship stored by the wind and heading
from S. W. to N. E. by S. all sail out and so ends

Tuesday January 25th
Sat 11:30 Long 11:30 P.M. Fine weather all
this day with light trades The ship stored by the
wind and heading from S. E. by S. to S. W. and so
ends

Wednesday January 26th
No Ob^r Fine weather all this day with
light breezes from S. E. The ship stored by the
wind and heading to S. all day all sail out
The water employed in making gun yarn
and so ends

Thursday January 27th
No Ob^r Fine weather all this day with light
breezes from S. E. The ship stored by the wind
and heading S. all day all sail out The mard
employed in ship's duty and so ends

Friday January 28th
Sat 4:35 Long 11:43 P.M. Fine weather all
this day with light breezes from S. E. The ship
stored by the wind and heading from S. to S. E.
and so ends
