Lat 820 Long 64th Fine weather
all this day with light breeze from S.E. & the
ship steered by the wind and heading from
S to S.W. and so on

Monday January 31st
Lat 810 Long 84th Fine weather
all this day with light breeze from S.E. Course
S.E. All day a W. wind down the main sail
and pointed the main yard the third at work
on the boat and so on

Tuesday February 1st
Lat 745 Long 101st Fine weather all
this day with light breeze from S.W. Course
S.W. Until sunset we then luffed to heading
to N.W. and shortened sail for the night
at sunrise made sail Course N.W. & the remain-
der of the day and so on

Wednesday February 2nd
Lat 700 Long 94th Fine weather
all this day with light breeze from N.W. Course
N.W. the first part the middle part heading
to S.W. under short sail. The latter part
course N.W. and so on

Thursday February 3rd
Lat 668 Long 101st Fine weather all
this day with day like breeze from N.W. and
the ship steered various courses during the day
crusing. At 10 saw black fish, lowered for them
but got none. Then the old main sail. The
water employed in the ship's duty and so on

Friday February 4th
Lat 623 Long 95th Fine weather all the
all this day the ship heading to S.W. with the first and
middle parts. The latter part Course S.W. & the remain-
der of the day and so on

Saturday February 5th
Lat 545 Long 95th Fine weather all this
day with light breeze from S. Course N.W. until 11
A.M. then shortened sail and luffed to heading
to S.W. At sun rise made sail and were to the
ship course N.W. until 9 A.M. N.W. & the remainder
of the day the water employed in breaking out
saw black fish and so on

Sunday February 6th
Lat 430 Long 93th The first part over-
cast with a shower of rain and light breeze from
S.W. Course N.W. until sunset then shortened
sail and more ship heading to S.W. with a fresh
breeze the latter part from S.W. The light sail
in and so on. Saw black fish

Monday February 7th
Lat 312 Long 87th Overcast most of this
day with fresh breeze from S.W. The ship steered
by the wind and on different tacks during the day
crusing. The water employed in breaking out
and so on

Tuesday February 8th
Lat 540 Long 88th Overcast most of this
day with fresh breeze S.W. The ship steered by the
wind all day and heading to S.W. The light sail in
most of the day and so on

Wednesday February 9th
No Obv. Overcast all this day with fresh
breeze from S.W. The ship heading from S.W.
to N.W. by the wind until 5 P.M. then luffed
to S.W. & S.W. tacked to W. going and headed so
the remainder of the day. S.W. gallant sail in
most of the day

Thursday February 10th
No Obv. Overcast all this day with light breeze
from S.W. The ship steered by the wind all day and
heading west. All sail set. The water employed in
the ship's duty and so on
