Thursday February 24th
No Obv^r Fine clear weather all this
day with light breeze from S.E. & the ship
steering by the wind under easy sail. St Helena
in sight to N.W. 25 miles distant. Several
sails in sight. And so ends

Friday February 25th
No Obv^r Fine weather the first part
with very light breeze from S.E. & the ship
steering by the wind. The middle part fresh breeze from S.E.
with rain squalls. The latter part squalls with
rain and light breeze from S.W. to S.E. & the
ship steering by the wind and on different tack
during the day. St Helena in sight to N.W.
And so ends

Saturday February 26th
No Obv^r Fine weather all this day with the
exception of a few light rain squalls. Light breeze
all day from S.E. & the ship steering by the
wind. Several sails in sight. St Helena in sight
to N.W. 20 miles distant. And so ends

Sunday February 27th
Fine weather all this day with light
breeze from S.E. & the ship steering by the
wind. St Helena in sight to N.W. 25 miles distant. Several
sails in sight. And so ends

Monday February 28th
Fine weather all this day with fresh
breeze from S.E. & the ship steering by the
wind. St Helena in sight to N.W. 25 miles distant. Several
sails in sight. The watch employed repairing flipper and so
ends

Tuesday February 29th
Light breeze most of this day from S.E.
with a few rain squalls. Several sails in sight.
The ship under easy sail steering by the wind. St Helena in
sight to N.W. 25 miles distant. And so ends

Wednesday March 1st
No Obv^r The first part a few light rain
squalls. Fresh breeze all day from S.E. & the
ship steering by the wind under easy sail and
on different tack during the day. St Helena
in sight to N.W. 25 miles distant. Also several
sails in sight. And so ends

Thursday March 2nd
No Obv^r The first part clear weather
the middle and latter part squalls. Fresh
breeze from S.E. & the ship steering by the
wind. The first part the middle
and latter parts fresh breeze from the same
quarter. Spike bark Ketchikan, St Helena
in sight to N.W. And so ends

Friday March 3rd
No Obv^r Clear weather most of this day
with fresh breeze. The ship steering by the wind
and on different tack during the day. St Helena
in sight to N.W. 25 miles distant. Several
sails in sight. And so ends

Saturday March 4th
No Obv^r Fine weather all this day with
fresh breeze from S.E. & the ship steering by
the wind and on different tack during
the day. St Helena in sight to N.W.
25 miles distant. And so ends
