Tuesday June 13<sup>th</sup>

Lat 830 Longitude 1098 Fine weather all this day with light breeze from S.W. Course N.W. until sunset. By the wind under sail heading. During the night course N.W. remainder of the day and so ends

Friday June 16<sup>th</sup>

Lat 738 Longitude 1038 Fine weather all this day with light breeze from S.W. The ship steered by the wind and on different tacks during the day. All sail in sight and so ends

Saturday June 17<sup>th</sup>

No Obi Fine weather all this day with light breeze from S.W. The ship steered by the wind and on different tacks during the day. All sail in sight and so ends

Sunday June 18<sup>th</sup>

Lat 842 Longitude 1019 Fine weather all this day with light breeze from S.W. The ship steered by the wind and on different tacks during the day. A.P.M. a whale was seen. It proved to be a large sperm whale going very slow to avoid a vessel for which it was chasing. The remainder of the day

Monday June 19<sup>th</sup>

Lat 830 Longitude 1039 Fine weather a good breeze from S.W. and a heavy swell on the sea. A vessel was seen about 4 P.M. the boat was seen. The whale was pursued and secured. It was got him along side at 7 P.M. and got ready to cut it. It was cut and everything the remainder of the day

Tuesday June 20<sup>th</sup>

No Obi Fine weather all this day with light breeze from S.W. All hands employed cutting and boiling and so ends

Wednesday June 21<sup>th</sup>

No Obi Fine weather all this day with light breeze from S.W. The ship steered by the wind and on different tacks during the day. A.M. spoke Bank of Oahu, and got rid of molasses from her
