Lat 720 S Long 102 W Overcast most of  
the day with light breeze from S.W. The ship steered  
middle parts. The ship heading to S. by the wind  
the latter part calm and so ends.

Friday July 7<sup>th</sup>  
No Cher. Overcast and calm the first  
part. The middle and latter parts light breeze from  
S. to S.W. The ship steered by the wind and heading  
from N.W. to S.W. and so ends.

Saturday July 8<sup>th</sup>  
No Cher. Overcast all this day with light breeze  
from S.W. to S. The ship heading from S. by  
the wind and so ends.

Sunday July 9<sup>th</sup>  
No Cher. Overcast all this day with light  
breezes from S.W. to S. The ship heading from S. by  
the wind and so ends.

Monday July 10<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 800 S Long 103 W Overcast most of this  
day with light breezes from S. The ship steered by the  
wind and heading to N.W. and so ends. A. M.  
humped back. The crew came up about lunch.

Tuesday July 11<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 830 S Long 104 W Overcast most of the  
day with light breezes from S. to S.W. The ship heading  
from N.W. to S.W. all day. A. M. The watch employed  
in repairing a top rail and so ends.

Wednesday July 12<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 910 S Long 105 W Overcast with light breeze  
from S. The ship steered by the wind and heading  
to S.W. all day. The watch employed in  
repairing sails and so ends.

Thursday July 13<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 938 S Overcast most of this day with  
light breezes from S.W. to S. The ship steered by  
the wind all day and heading from N.W. to S.W.  
The watch employed on top rail and so ends.

Friday July 14<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 1001 S Long 106 W Fine weather all this  
day with light breeze from S. The ship steered by  
the wind and heading to S.W. at 10 P.M. A. M. saw  
several whales going. A. M. lowered the boat at the  
end of this day.

Saturday July 15<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 1020 S Long 107 W Fine weather all this  
day with light breeze from S. The boat down chase  
in whales. The boat struck and got a whale.  
The other boats chased until sunset. The ship  
steered by the wind the remainder of the day, cutting  
in the latter part and so ends.

Sunday July 16<sup>th</sup>  
No Cher. Fine weather all this day with fresh  
breezes from S. to S.W. A. M. finished cutting  
the remainder of the day. The ship steered by the  
wind and heading from N.W. to S.W. The  
watch employed in cutting up blubber and  
boiling and so ends.
