

Sunday August 13th
Lat 15° 22' Long 44° 44' Fine weather all
this day with fresh breeze from S. E. Course
S. by E. At sunset double reefed and hauled the main
sail up. At 7 A. M. saw the land S. by E. and
kept off to N. W. W. for the land and so on.

Monday August 14th
Strong breeze all this day. Course N. by E.
until 6 P. M. we then went to S. by E. and
bearing N. W. W. 4 miles distant the remainder of
the day off and on, at 11 A. M. and so on.

Tuesday August 15th
At 2 P. M. came to anchor at St. Helena
and landed the sails and rigging, breaking
out Anker water during the night. After
past all hands employed breaking out and
sowing for water and washing ship and
anchors.

Wednesday August 16th
One watch on liberty. The other
employed in breaking out and stowing
for water.

Thursday August 17th
One watch on liberty. The other employed
in taking on board water and wood and so on.

Friday August 18th
One watch on liberty. The other employed
in getting off wood and stowing it away and so
on.

Saturday August 19th
One watch on liberty. The other employed
in getting off wood and stowing it away and so
on.

Sunday August 20th
Fine weather all this day. All
hands on board and so on.

Monday August 21th
All hands on board all this day. In a.m. they
got in getting of stores and getting the ship
ready for sea. And so on.

Tuesday August 22th
All hands on board. Getting the ship ready
for sea. Got off water and potatoes, pumpkins, &c.
peas and fruit. And at 11 P. M. set the gear
underweigh and sailed out to sea. Stowed anchors
and chains and so on.

Wednesday August 23th
Off and on. At 11 A. M. the sea was
account. The captain then came off. The ship
shared by the wind the remainder of the day
and heading from N. E. by E. to E. and so on.
A light breeze from S. E. and so on.
