until about 10 AM. The remainder of the day the ship
steered by the wind and on different tacks
during the time. A sail in sight at noon
and we passed her ship sail.

Sunday September 10th
Lat 51° 45' Long 98° 0' Clear weather most
of the day with light breeze from W. Course N.E.
until about 10 AM. The ship steered by the wind
and on different tacks during the day. And no ends.

Monday September 11th
No Ob^r. Overcast most of this day with calm
and light air from W. The ship steered by the
wind and on different tacks during the day. And
no ends.

Tuesday September 12th
Lat 54° 00' Long 98° 0' Clear weather most
of the day with light air from W. Course N.E.
until about 10 AM. The ship steered by the wind
and on different tacks during the time.
And no ends.

Wednesday September 13th
Lat 54° 45' Long 98° 0' Overcast most of the
day with light air from W. The ship steered by
the wind all day and on different tacks. A sail in
sight at noon and no ends.

Thursday September 14th
Lat 55° 30' Long 98° 0' Overcast most of
this day with light breeze from W. The
ship steered by the wind all day and on differ-
ent tacks during the time. And no ends.

Friday September 15th
Lat 56° 30' Long 98° 0' Overcast most of this day with
breeze from W. At 11 AM saw a sperm whale going to
windward and lowered 4 boats and chased. The whales
turned and came toward and the west boat struck

a large whale the remains being very small.
All hands went for the big one and surprised himself
got him along side at 1 PM. got ready to cut during the
night. It is a sperm whale in sight toward 8 boats
but they were going very quick to windward and gave them
up and some on board. All hands employed. The remain-
der of this day cutting. And no more. One man off duty for hunt.
fell down main hatch.

Saturday September 16th
No Ob^r. Overcast most of this day with light
breeze from W. The ship steered by the wind all day.
Hands employed, cut in the body of the
first part and commenced sealing. The eastern
part however the head. And a black fish. All
hands busy closing up. And no ends.

Sunday September 17th
No Ob^r. Overcast most of this day with
light air from W. The ship steered by the
wind all day and heading to S.E. All hands employ-
ed in hoisting and taking care of oil. And no ends.
A black fish.

Monday September 18th
No Ob^r. Overcast most of this day with
light air from W. The ship steered by the wind
and on different tacks during the day. A whale
hooked at 11 AM and got 3 whales. No ends from her.
Finished killing at 11 AM. This whale turned up
180 lbs. A number of sails in sight. And no ends.

Tuesday September 19th
No Ob^r. Overcast most of this day with light
breeze from W. The ship steered by the wind and
on different tacks during the day. A whale
hooked at 11 AM. The whale was employed in a ship during
the day. And no ends.
