Thursday September 21st
No Ob^r. Overcast most of this day with
light breezes from S.W. The ship steered by
the wind and on different tacks during the
day. And no ends.

Friday September 22nd
Lat 7° 15' Long 101° 2' Overcast most of this
day with light breezes from S.W. The ship steered by
the wind all day and on different tacks. A sail
in sight. The watch employed in sails and
no ends.

Saturday September 23rd
Lat 7° 38' Long 101° 8' Overcast most
of this day with light breezes from S.W. at 10 A.M.
The ship steered by the wind all day and on
different tacks. A sail in sight. And no ends.

Sunday September 24th
Lat 7° 45' Long 102° 2' Overcast most of this
day with light breezes from S.W. at 10 A.M. The ship steered
by the wind and on different tacks during the day.
A.M. saw black fish, two sails in sight and no ends.

Monday September 25th
Lat 7° 40' Long 102° 5' Overcast most of this
day with calm and light breezes from S.W. The
ship steered by the wind and on different
tacks during the day. Saw hump backs and
black fish. A.M. A sail in sight and
no ends.

Tuesday September 26th
Lat 7° 59' Long 94° 4' Overcast most of this day
with very light air from S.W. The ship steered by the
wind and on different tacks during the day. A sail in
sight. At 9 A.M. saw a large hump back whale, lowered
and hoisted him. The remainder of the day A sail
in sight.

Wednesday September 27th
Lat 8° 00' Long 101° 5' Clear weather most
of this day with light breezes from S.W. The boat
down chasing the whale until sunset, got on board
at 8 P.M. The remainder of the day The ship steered
by the wind and on different tacks. And no ends.

Thursday September 28th
No Ob^r. Overcast most of this day with
light breezes from S.W. at 10 A.M. 10 P.M.
saw hump back whales going to N.E. lowered and hoisted
board and hoisted each got a small whale
got them along side at 8 P.M. got ready to cut the
latter part but them in and hoisted forward ready
to S.E. And no ends.

Friday September 29th

light breezes from S.W. The ship steered by the
wind and on different tacks during the day. The
watch employed in sailing. A.M. finished these
whales turned up 34 bbls. A sail in sight and
no ends.

Saturday September 30th

Helena, sailing. Saw hump backs. The ship steered
by the wind all day and on different tacks.

the wind and on different tacks during the day. A
sail in sight and no ends.
