got off a raft of water and healed the ship and stopped
A leak on the Mainboard beam.

Friday December 8th
Fine weather all this day. All hands
employed in getting water and stowing it

Saturday December 9th
Fine weather all this day. All hands employed
Ligging 3 boats out fishing. The Mainboard in place
washing ship. The Captain went on shore
after noon and two of the men got drunk. Thomas
Higgins & William Black. They did not come off
in the boat but came on board in another boat. At
sun set, after they got on board Black went to sitting
and drove one man down into the cabin with a
iron belay pin. put pump irons. During the row the
William George Cook, Frank Costa, Robert Costen
told the boat from along side and away. Landed
three boats and went after them. Found the boat on
on the back shore with three oars and pine gear on
got on board at mid night and so ends this day.

Sunday December 10th
Fine weather all hands on board

Monday December 11th
Fine weather all this day. All hands employed
The second Mate abating for a business language and
in compliance, P.M. got off 28 bags of potatoes and stowed
the way. End so ends

Tuesday December 12th
Fine weather all hands on board got off some fruit
and corn and fish salted the fish

Wednesday December 13th
Fine weather all hands on board got off employ
ed at ad jets

Thursday December 14th
Fine weather all this day. All hands on board
got off some fruit and pumpkins also two of the
Deputies Robert Costen and Frank Costa put them in
the run in irons

Friday December 15th
Fine weather all hands on board received on
one live bullock and a pot of pumpkins and the last
of the runaway William George confined him in the
run in irons.

Saturday December 16th
Fine weather all hands on board and the
ship ready for sea. Some short and soiled sails
saw us all day blowing into the bay. At sun
set hauled every thing up and prayed out. Done
and made all fast for the night

Sunday December 17th
Fine weather and calm until 4 P.M. All
hands on board and ready for sea waiting for wind

Monday December 18th
Fine weather all hands on board
and ready for sea. Main wind

Tuesday December 19th
Fine weather all this day. At 2 P.M. sea
account we got under way and headed out
to sea cleared the land at 5 P.M. and stowed
ashore in chutes the middle and latter part
light breeze from S.W. and N.W. The ship
tossed by the wind and on different
tides the wind in night N.W. and so ends
