and restowing it.

Tuesday April 8th
All hands employed in breaking out
ground then stowing back and filling it again

Wednesday April 9th
All hands employed in breaking out

All hands employed breaking out and
re stowing, total load of provisions from Long
J. A. Ross

Friday April 11th
All hands employed breaking out
and stowing back

Saturday April 12th
All hands employed stowing and filling
ground, got to later load of provisions from Long
J. A. Ross

Sunday April 13th
One watch on liberty

Monday April 14th
All hands employed taking in water and
stowing it. Discharged William Black, sick

Tuesday April 15th
All hands employed stowing water and provisions

Wednesday April 16th
One watch on liberty the other employed
washing ship

Thursday April 17th
One watch on liberty the other employed
taking in stores cooking meat and stowing it.
Discharged the 4th Mate, this day

Friday April 18th
One watch on liberty the other employed
in ships duty. Got off a later load of wood and
stowed it.

Saturday April 19th
All hands on board and the ship ready
for sea

Sunday April 20th
At 9 P.M. sea calm we got under weigh and
stood out sea. Got on the remainder of this
day the captain overscore, Mr. Rice third
officer came on board to duty and went to duty.

Monday April 21th
Off and on at Helena all this day
as usual

Tuesday April 22th
Off and on until 4 P.M. The captain
then came on board, the ship steered by the
wind the remainder of the day and did several
tacks. Wind fair S.W.

Wednesday April 23th
Fine weather all this day with fresh breeze
from S.W. The ship steered by the wind all day
and reaching to 3 P.M. got under way at Helena bore
to N.W. 20 miles distant. At 10, ran a sail
