board at sunset. The Bark Desdemona came
in to anchor to the side of us. The latter part
too sea off cruising for Androschows.

Fine weather with calms and light airs.
The boats down cruising for whales and Androschows.

Sunday June 10th
Fine weather and calm most of the
day. All hands on board.

Monday June 11th
Fine weather with light airs and
calms. The boats down cruising for whales.

Tuesday June 12th
Fine weather with light breezes and calms.
The boats down looking for whales during the
day.

Wednesday June 13th
Fine weather with light breezes and calms.
The boats down all day looking for whales. Boat
on board at sunset.

Thursday June 14th
Fine weather with calms and light
breezes. The boats down chasing whales. The Captain
struck and drew. All came on board at sunset.

Friday June 15th
Fine weather and calms and light sea
breezes. The boats down all day looking for whales.

Saturday June 16th
