Monday June 25th
Fine weather with calms and

light until sunset looking for whales
saw nothing

Tuesday June 26th
Fine weather with very heavy dews and
calms and light sea airs. 3 boats down until
sunset looking for whales. The ship began
got the ship under weigh and headed to N
until 5 P.M. and then came to anchor in
12 fathoms 3 or 4 miles from the land

Wednesday June 27th
Overcast this day with calms and light
sea breezes. 3 boats down looking for whales
saw two and chased until noon sunset
The ship got under weigh at daylight and
headed to N until 5 P.M. and then came to anchor
in 17 fathoms 7 or 8 miles from land

Thursday June 28th
Smoked and overcast. Most of this day
and very dark. 3 boats down from daylight until
sunset. Saw two whales but could not get
cast to them

Friday June 29th
Overcast most of this with light sea breezes
3 boats down after whales saw numbers and
chased them out of town

Saturday June 30th
Overcast most of this day with calms and
light sea breezes. The boats down from daylight
until sunset saw a few whales going every way

Sunday July 1st
Overcast most of this day with light
sea airs. All hands on board. At 10 A.M. 2 whales
passed the ship. Lowered the boats and chased
them as while but could not get on

Monday July 2nd
Overcast most of this day with light sea
breezes. At under weigh at daylight and
sent the boat after whales. Retained at sun
set. The ship heading to N along the land
until 5 P.M. and then came to anchor in 16
fathoms 8 miles from shore saw nothing this
day

Tuesday July 3rd
Fine weather with light sea breezes from
S.E. At daylight got under weigh and
headed to N.W. across the Congo river, saw
A hump back and chased him out of town

Wednesday July 4th
Smoky weather. Most of this day with
very light breeze from S.E. The ship head
ing from N.W. to E. until 10 P.M. The
was anchored in 18 fathoms. At daylight got under
weigh and headed to Eastward in for the land
and down
