

Thursday July 5th

Fine weather most of this day with light airs from S & E with calms. The ship heading to eastward. At 4 P.M. came to anchor in 6 fathoms about 6 miles from shore of Calenda. The Captain went on shore and returned at 5 P.M. with a few oranges and fowls. At day light got under weigh and headed to Northward along the land. Several Cones came along with green oranges.

Friday July 6th

Overcast most of this day with light sea and land breezes with some calm. The ship heading to Northward along the land same base hor at 9 a.m. set in 20 fathoms & 4 miles from shore. At day light got under weigh. Three boats went in shore looking for whales. Saw a small hump back. Struck and got him, towing to the shore at the close of this day.

Saturday July 7th

Overcast with calms and light sea. At 10 a.m. a whale to the ship at 4 P.M. and cut him. 2 Boats off cruising until sunset. At day light lowered 3 Boats and raised. The remainder of this day.

Sunday July 8th

Fine weather all hand on board. At 6 a.m. sweet time started the pumps and done finished boiling. And sends their boy.

Monday July 9th

Fine weather and light airs from S & E and a strong current running to N.E. At day lowered 2 Boats. The remainder of the ship's company got the ship under weigh and headed to N.E. until 4 P.M. and anchored again. The boats returned at dark. Saw no whale. Hudson

Tuesday July 10th

Fine weather and light breezes from S & E with a very strong current. The boats down all day but saw nothing.

Wednesday July 11th

Overcast most of this day with light breezes. The boats down from day light until sunset. Saw one whale going quick.

Thursday July 12th

Fine weather with light breezes. The boats down from day light until sunset and one small whale going like the devil.

Friday July 13th

Overcast all this day with some rain. At day light got under weigh and headed to N along the land. 3 Boats down all day after whales. Anchored again at 4 P.M. in 19 fathoms, & the tenor of Boango.

Saturday July 14th

Overcast all this day with calm most of the time. 3 Boats down from day light until sunset. Spacing but could not get past the ship. got under weigh and went to N until 5 P.M. and anchored in 19 fathoms 400 miles from land.

Sunday July 15th

Overcast all this day. All hands on board. At 9 A.M. got under weigh and headed to Northward along the land until 4 P.M. with a light air from S and then anchored in 17 fathoms.

Monday July 16th

Clear weather most of this day with calms and light airs. 3 Boats down from day light until dark. Saw three whales, but could not get near them.
