Tuesday September 30th
No Obv. Overcast most of this day with light breezes from S.W. The ship steered by the wind all day and heading to W.N.W. The water employed boiling and taking care of oil and so ends

Wednesday September 30th
No Obv. Overcast most of this day with light breezes from S.W. The ship heading to W.N.W. at 2 P.M. saw sperm whales around the boat and the worst boat struck and got a whale got him alongside at sunset. The water employed boiling. At 11 P.M. the whale in and headed to W.N.W. by the wind and so ends

Thursday September 30th
Lat 9° 13' Long 93° 1' Overcast most of this day with light breezes from S.W. The ship steered by the wind all day and heading to W.N.W. The water employed boiling and so ends

Friday September 30th
No Obv. Overcast most of this day with light breezes from S.W. The ship steered by the wind all day and heading to W.N.W. The water employed boiling. At 11 P.M. all hands employed showing down H. Bail stowed down 11 casks and 8 gallons Reg. the Bung gaps. The casks not filled up

Saturday September 30th
No Obv. Overcast most of this day with light breezes from S.W. The ship steered by the wind all day and heading to W.N.W. by the wind and so ends

Monday September 30th
Lat 9° 19' Long 93° 1' Overcast most of this day with light breezes from S.W. The first and middle parts the latter part fresh breezes from S.W. The light sails in. The ship steered by the wind all day and heading to W.N.W. by the wind and so ends

Tuesday October 1st
No Obv. Overcast most of this day with good breezes from S.W. The ship steered by the wind all day and heading to W.N.W. The water employed boiling. The flat catch of Sperm Oil 196 lbs 11 casks

Wednesday October 1st
No Obv. Overcast with fresh S.W. The ship steered by the wind all day and heading to W.N.W. by the wind and so ends

Thursday October 1st
Lat 9° 35' Long 93° 1' Overcast most of the day with a good breeze from S.W. The ship steered by the wind all day and heading to W.N.W. by the wind and so ends

Friday October 1st
Lat 10° 10' Long 93° 1' Overcast most of this day with fresh breezes from S.W. The ship steered by the wind and heading to W.N.W. by the wind and so ends. A large sperm whale lowered 3 boats at 11 P.M. for him and so ends

Saturday October 1st
Lat 11° 00' Long 93° 1' Overcast most of this day with fresh breezes from S.W. The worst boat struck the whale. All hands went for him and commenced killing him. All hands employed cutting and so ends

Sunday October 1st
Lat 11° 15' Long 93° 1' Overcast most of this day with light breezes from S.W. The ship steered by the wind all day and heading to W.N.W. The water employed boiling. At 11 P.M. all hands employed showing down H. Bail stowed down 11 casks and 8 gallons Reg. the Bung gaps. The casks not filled up
