Tuesday Jan 15th Gentle breezes from the NE and pleasant
weather. Sent up Mizzen Top & Mast & Sail and set the Sail. Steered
SSE & South. Lat Obs 19° 31' Long 26° 50' W

Wednesday Jan 16th Gentle breezes from the Eastward and pleasant
weather. Took a Lunar observation and the longitude deduced was 26° 10'
Steered SSE. Lat Obs 17° 13' N Long 26° 00' W

Thursday Jan 17th Light winds and pleasant weather. Wind East.
Strong indications of being near land. Lay too at night.
Steered SSE. Lat Obs 16° 13' N Long 25° 45' W

Friday Jan 18th First part fair weather and light breezes. Middle
& latter part squally with rain, thunder and lightning.
Lat 15° 25' N Long 25° 20' W

Saturday Jan 19th First part fair weather & unsteady breezes
from SSE to ENE. Dark clouds to windward which I suspect
to hang over the Islands of Stago and Brava, two of the Cape
De Verde Islands. Latter part gentle gale and fair weather.
Lat Obs 12° 54' N Long 25° 13'

Sunday Jan 20th First & Middle part fine gale & fair weather.
Latter part squally with rain. Sun obscured. No obs. Long) 24° 30'

Monday Jan 21st Fresh gale and cloudy with rain. Steered SE.
Sun Obscured No obs Long) 24° 10' W

Tuesday Jan 22^d. Continued fresh gale with rain. Latter part
more pleasant. Lat Obs 4° 38' N Long) 23° 40' W

Wednesday Jan 23^d. First part moderate breezes & pleasant.
Middle & Latter part fresh gale with rain. Steered SSE. Wind East.
Sun Obscured No obs Long) 23° 15' W

Thursday Jan 24th Light winds and pleasant weather.
Steered to the Southward. Wind from NE to SE.
Lat 00° 57' N Long) 23° 15'

Friday Jan 25th Light variable winds & calms. Saw a Schooner
standing to the Westward  Lat Obs 00° 40' N Long 23° 20' W

Saturday Jan 26th 1833 Light winds and calms and warm
pleasant weather. Lat Obs 00° 15' N Long) 23° 00' W

Sunday Jan 27th Light airs and calms & warm pleasant
weather. At Sunset saw two Sails to the Northward. At noon
one of them bore NE and the other West. Saw another in com-
pany with the one bearing NE. Lat Obs 00° 02' N Long) 23° 05'

Monday Jan 28th Light breezes and pleasant weather. All
Sail set by the wind. At 9 AM spoke Whaling Ship Corinthian
Grinnell of and from Bristol N.S. Informs that the Ship he was
in company with yesterday was the Lydia of Portsmouth N.H. for
Rio Janeiro. Rigger out the Flying jibb boom. Bent the Flying jib & set it.
Steered SE.  Lat Obs 00° 46' S Long 24° 26' W

Tuesday Jan 29th Moderate breezes and pleasant weather. Rigger
a Sprintsail bar. Wind East. Steered SE. Lat Obs 2° 00' S
Long 25° 47' W

Wednesday Jan 30th Moderate breezes, fine pleasant weather and a
smooth sea. Steered SE & SSE. Lat Obs 2° 52' S Long 27° 08' W

Thursday Jan 31st Fresh breezes and pleasant weather. Steered
SE. At daylight saw a Ship steering to the NW.
Lat Obs 4° 35' S Long 28° 24' W

Friday February 1st Fresh breezes from the SE & pleasant
weather. Sail set to the best advantage by the wind. Steering
to the Southward. Lat Obs 6° 42' S Long 29° 00' W

Saturday Feb 2nd Fresh breezes and pleasant weather. Fitted
a new pair of 8 1/2 ft Backstays. Lat Obs 9° 17' S Long 29° 08' W

Sunday Feb 3rd Moderate winds and fair weather. Saw a Ship
standing to the NW. Steered by the wind to the Southward. This
is the forty fifth day since I came on board and as I have had
but little leisure time have made but few remarks.
