Sunday June 9th Northerly windy and cloudy weather. All ready for sea waiting a wind which now blows into the harbor. Arrived yesterday Ship Hellispoint, Henry of Boston last from Valparaiso bound from hence to the Sandwich Islands.

Monday June 10th Cloudy weather with light air and calms. At noon a light breeze sprang up from N.E. At 3 P.M. weighed anchor, made sail and proceeded to sea in company with a French Brig for Puyta. At 5 P.M. the West end of the Island of Saint Lorenzo bore S.E. I now re-commenced by nautical computation being

Tuesday June 11th Calms and light air of wind. The harbor of Callao & Island of Saint Lorenzo in sight

Wednesday June 12th First part light breeze from S.E. At 6 P.M. the Island of Saint Lorenzo bore S.E. 7 leagues distant. Untoed the cables & put them below and stowed the anchors on the bow.

Thursday June 13th Light winds and clear weather. Saw Pintacks and Blackfish.
Lat Obs 10° 23' S Long 78° 19'

Friday June 14th Light winds and a heavy atmosphere. Saw Blackfish and Pintack and Humpback Whales.
Lat Obs 9° 04' S Long 78° 40'

Saturday June 15th Light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather. At 1 P.M. saw the land. At 5 P.M. started off West from it. Saw Pintacks, Humpbacks & Blackfish.
Lat Obs 8° 29' S Long 80° 05' W

Sunday June 16th Light winds and pleasant weather. Steered to the W. I. W. Saw Pintacks & Blackfish. Lat Obs 7° 46' S Long 81° 45' W

Monday June 17th 1833. Fresh breezes and fair weather. Steered to the W. I. W. Saw Pintacks & Blackfish. Lat Obs 7° 34' N Long 83° 30' W

Tuesday June 18th Fair weather with strong S.E. trade winds and flying clouds. Saw Blackfish Lat Obs 7° 04' S Long 84° 49' W

Wednesday June 19th Strong trade and fair weather. Saw nothing Lat Obs 5° 24' S Long 87° 40'

Thursday June 20th Fresh gales and squally. Saw a Pintack and Blackfish. Lat Obs 5° 41' S Long 86° 45' W

Friday June 21th Fresh gales and squally weather. Steered to the N.E. under easy sail. Saw Blackfish Lat Obs 4° 44' S Long 85° 50' W

Saturday June 22th Strong winds and squally weather. Steered to S.W. by the wind. Saw Blackfish Lat Obs 5° 14' S Long 87° 11' W

Sunday June 23th Strong S.E. trade winds & occasional squalls. Steered to N.W. Saw Blackfish Lat Obs 4° 40' S Long 87° 57' W

Monday June 24th Light S.E. trades and fair weather. At 3 P.M. took a Lunar Observation and the Longitude deduced was 88° 08' W. Steered North. Lat Obs 3° 52' S Long 88° 08' W

Tuesday June 25th Light winds and fair weather. Steered to the Northward. Saw nothing. Lat Obs 2° 36' S Long 87° 53' W

Wednesday June 26th Light winds and squally with light rains. Saw several Shoals of Porpoises. Lat Obs 1° 34' S Long 88° 10' W

Thursday June 27th First part squally with rain. Latter part fresh trades & pleasant weather. Saw Porpoises & Blackfish. Lat Obs 1° 12' S Long 89° 15' W

Friday June 28th Breeze breezes and pleasant weather. At 1 P.M. ^{saw} two of the Galapagos Islands viz Chatham Island
