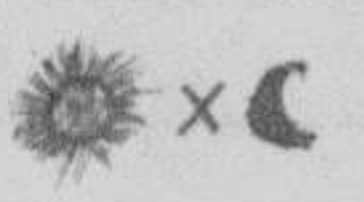


Sunday October 20th 1833. Fresh breezes & cloudy weather. Steering to the E & N by the wind. At 9 A.M. tacked to the S.W. Lat Obs 3° 53' S Long 89° 30' W

Monday Oct. 21st Light breezes and fair weather. Steering to the S.W. by the wind. At 5 P.M. took several Lunar distance and the Longitude deduced was 89° 40' W. At 8 A.M. tacked to the E & N.  Lat Obs 4° 42' S Long 89° 55' W

Tuesday Oct. 22 Light winds and clear pleasant weather. At 5 P.M. saw several Sperm Whales to windward. Lowered the three Boats in pursuit. Returned a little after Sundown having taken none. Steered to the S.W. by the wind. At 10 A.M. saw a lone Sperm Whale. Lowered the Boats but the Whale turned flukes & went down and we saw nothing more of it. At noon took up the Boats Lat Obs 5° 58' S Long 88° 50' W 

Wednesday Oct. 23 Light winds and pleasant weather. Steering to the S.W. At 10 P.M. tacked to the E & N. Saw the Golconda Lat Obs 5° 16' S Long 89° 48' W

Thursday Oct. 24 Light winds and pleasant weather. Spoke the Golconda who had taken a 20 Bbl Whale since we spoke with her before. Steered to the E & N by the wind. Saw Finbacks  Lat Obs 5° 06' S Long 89° 00' W

Friday Oct. 25 Light winds and clear pleasant weather. Steering to the E & N by the wind. Saw Finbacks & porpoises. Lat Obs 4° 55' S Long 88° 20' W

Saturday October 26 Fine pleasant weather & moderate trade winds. Steered to the E & N by the wind. Saw Finbacks Blackfish & porpoises. Lat Obs 4° 35' S Long 87° 38' W

Sunday October 27 Gentle gales and fine pleasant weather. Steered to the E & N by the wind. At 11 P.M. tacked to the S.W. Painting Ship.  Lat Obs 4° 31' S Long 87° 15' W

Monday October 28th 1833. Light breezes & fair weather. Steered to the Westward. Saw Finbacks & Blackfish. Painting Ship.  Lat Obs 4° 25' S Long 88° 48' W

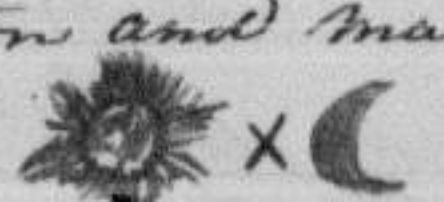
Tuesday Oct. 29 Light winds & pleasant weather. Passed the carcass of a dead Whale. Steered to the S.W. Painting Ship  Lat Obs 4° 51' S Long 89° 40' W

Wednesday Oct. 30 Gentle breezes and fair weather. Steered to the S.W. Saw Blackfish. Lat Obs 5° 37' S Long 90° 30' W

Thursday Oct. 31 Fine breezes and clear pleasant weather. Steered to the West & N.W. Saw Blackfish & Whale Killers. Lat Obs 5° 29' S Long 90° 53' W

Friday November 1st Light winds and fair weather. Steered to the S.W. and during the night to the E & N. Lat Obs 5° 34' S Long 91° 20' W

Saturday November 2. Moderate breezes & pleasant weather. At 2 P.M. lowered the Boat for two Sword Fish but did not get them. At 3 P.M. saw Sperm Whales from the Main by W Shearman, off the lee beam. At 4 P.M. lowered the three Boats in pursuit. Waist Boat struck one but the iron drew. The whales then having got to windward of the Boats, and they chased till Sundown but got nothing. Steered to the S.W. by the wind through the night. At 7 A.M. tacked to the E & N. Lat Obs 4° 14' S Long 91° 34' W

Sunday Nov. 3 Moderate trade winds and fair weather. Steered to the S.W. & E & N by the wind. Saw nothing. Lat Obs 4° 09' S Long 91° 50' Took a Lunar observation and made the Longitude 91° 50'. 

Monday Nov. 4 Moderate trade winds and fair weather. Steered to the N.E. and at night by the wind to the S.W. at 7 A.M. tacked to the E & N by the wind. Lat Obs 3° 36' S Long 91° 35' W

Tuesday Nov 5th Brisk breezes and fair weather. Steered to the North & East. Saw nothing. Lat Obs 3° 01' S Long 90° 40' W
