

Tuesday July 29. 1834 Light winds and fair weather.
Steered to N.E. by the wind. Saw nothing more of the spots
although I think they were Sperm Whales. At Sundown
tacked & stood to the Northw. by the wind.

At Daylight commenced stowing down oil. Lat Obs 33° 51' N
Long 176° 00' W

Wednesday July 30 Light winds and calm and pleasant
weather. At Sundown finished stowing oil & washed off the
Ship. Steered to N.E. Latter part commenced painting
Ship outside & varnishing the waist. Saw Porpoises & Hairy

Lat Obs 34° 30' N

Long 175° 20' W

Thursday July 31 Moderate breeze & pleasant weather.
Had some slight squalls with rain during the night.
Steered to the Eastward. Wind South. At 7 A.M. tacked
to S.W. At 9 A.M. took a Lunar Observation and the
Longitude deduced was 174° 33' W. Lat Obs 34° 25' N

Long 174° 40' W

Friday August 1st Fresh breeze and pleasant weather.
Steered to S.W. Shortened Sail at night. Daylight saw
jib & m & g. Sail. At 6 A.M. tacked to N.E. Continued
painting outside the Ship. At 9 A.M. took in jib & m & g.
Sail. Took a Lunar Observation and the Longitude deduced
was 175° 25' W. Lat Obs 34° 06' N

Long 175° 20' W

Saturday Aug² Fresh breeze and fair weather. At
1 P.M. finished main course & tacked to South & West.
Saw a number of breaches & spots which we ascertained to
be made by a fish called by whalers jumpers or Thrushes.
There have been plenty of Albicor & Bonetas following
alongside the Ship these three weeks past and we take them
out of the water to cook, as we want them.

Sunday August 3. 1834 Fresh gales and pleasant weather.
Steered to the Southward by the wind. Wind E.S. At 10.30
P.M. went to N.E. Saw nothing. Lat Obs 33° 16' N
Long 175° 57' W

Monday August 4th Fresh gales and pleasant weather with
a large sea. Steered to N.E. by the wind. Daylight tacked
to Southw. Saw Porpoises. All hands stowing oil & beating
out in the main hold when several Casks were discovered
that leaked badly. Took them up and cooped them. At
11 A.M. tacked to N.E. Lat Obs 34° 00' N

Longitude 175° 45' W

Tuesday August 5th Light breeze and pleasant weather.
Steered to N.E. by the wind. At Daylight tacked to
Southw. All hands stowing oil. Lat Obs 34° 16' N
Long 175° 33' W

Wednesday Aug⁶ Light windy smooth sea & pleasant weather.
At 3 P.M. finished stowing in the hold and washed off.
Tacked to N.E. Latter part calm. Unbent the main course
repaired and rebent it. Lat Obs 34° 27' N

Long 175° 06' W

Thursday Aug⁷ Light winds from the S.E. and
warm pleasant weather. Steered to the E.S. Repaired
the Sparker. Saw Porpoises & two Kingfishers. Pumped a
quantity of Gummy Oil. Lat Obs 34° 36' N

Long 174° 26' W

Friday August 8. Light winds and pleasant weather.
Steered to the Eastward. Unbent the fore course & repaired it.
At 7 A.M. went to S.W. Pumped a quantity of Gummy
& oil. Saw Porpoises & jumpers. Lat Obs 34° 53' N

Long 174° 20' W

Saturday August 9th Light winds and pleasant weather.
Middle & Latter part, squalls with rain & cloudy weather.
Steered to the W.S. Saw jumpers & Porpoises. At
11 A.M. tacked & steered to the Eastward. Lat Obs 35° 02' N

Long 174° 30' W
