

Wednesday April 1st 1835. Strong N.E. trades and fair weather. Steered N.W. Lat Obs 9° 50' N Long 44° 04' W.

Thursday April 2^d Fresh N.E. trades and pleasant weather. Steered N.W. & S. Set S. & T. Steering Sails and T. and M. & G. Sails. Lat Obs 12° 10' N Long 46° 45' W.

Friday April 3^d Gentle trade winds and fine pleasant weather. At 3 P.M. took a set of Lunar Distances and the Longitude deduced was 47° 05' W. Steered N.W. & S. Set S. & G. Steering Sails. Lat Obs 14° 10' N Long 48° 50' W.

Saturday April 4th Gentle trade winds & pleasant weather. Steered N.W. & S. Longitude by Lunar 3 P.M. 48° 57' W. Lat Obs 15° 38' N Long 49° 44' W.

Sunday April 5th Gentle breezes and fine pleasant weather. Steering N.W. & S. Wind N.E. Saw a quantity of Gulf Weed. Took in Steering Sails & braced Shrouds by the wind. Lat Obs 17° 31' N Longitude by Lunar 3 P.M. 50° 38' W. Long 53° 10' W.

Monday April 6th Bright breezes and pleasant weather. Steered N.W. & S. Wind N.E. and latter part E. & S. Set topmost & Top. & Steering Sails. Saw a Sail off the lee bow from the Mast Head. Lat Obs 19° 15' N Long by Lunar 4 P.M. 52° 34' W. Long 54° 00' W.

Tuesday April 7th Fresh trades with occasional squalls. Steered N.W. & S. Wind N.E. to E.S. Took in and set Steering Sails as occasion required. Lat Obs 21° 10' N Long 55° 50' W.

Wednesday April 8th Gentle trade winds from East inclining Southerly and pleasant weather. Steered N.W. At noon saw 3 Barges Steering to the N.E. Lat Obs 22° 40' N Long by Lunar 4 P.M. 56° 11' W. Long 57° 00' W.

Thursday April 9th 1835. First part gentle breezes from S.W. to W. & S. and pleasant weather. Latter part light variable winds and calms. At 10 A.M. tacked to W. & S. Lat Obs 23° 58' N Long by Lunar 4 P.M. 57° 41' W. Long 58° 40' W.

Friday April 10th Moderate breezes from N.E. & S.E. and open cloudy weather. Steered N.W. & S. At 2 A.M. saw a Sail apparently standing to the Westward. Lat Obs 24° 38' N Long 60° 35' W.

Saturday April 11th Gentle breezes from the Eastward inclining Southerly and pleasant weather. At 10 P.M. saw 2 Herm. Bigs Steering Southerly. At 7 A.M. an Hermaphrodite Big crossed ahead of us Steering South. Lat Obs 25° 54' N Long 61° 58' W.

Sunday April 12th First & Middle part gentle breezes from the S.E. and pleasant weather. Latter part fresh increasing breezes from the South & S.W. and thick cloudy weather. Steered N.W. Lat Obs 27° 04' N Long 63° 16' W.

Monday April 13th Commenced strong breezes from S.W. At 2 P.M. the wind hauled to the Westward in a heavy squall. Took in light Sails & reefed Topmasts. At 7 P.M. wind hauling Northerly tacked to Westward. Latter part strong breezes from S.E. & North. Lat Obs 28° 13' N Long 65° 02' W.

Tuesday April 14th Light winds varying from N.E. to W.N.W. and pleasant weather. Steered by the wind. At sunset saw a square rigged vessel standing to the Southward. Lat Obs 28° 45' N Long 65° 40' W.

Wednesday April 15th Moderate breezes from the West and cloudy weather. At 5 A.M. wind hauling to the S.W.
