

Ship George of New Bedford Whaling

Sunday Nov 6th

Commences with strong breezes from N.W. middle parts squally at 10 P.M. clewed down double reefed the topsails at day light squally with rain so ends this day rugged.

Course S.W. Lat by Obs Lon 15.1

Monday Nov 7th

Commences with rugged weather standing to Southward & Eastward, middle parts squally at 11 P.M. tacked to S.W. at 1 P.M. clewed down & double reefed the 4 took in 1st & spanker at 7 main sail close reefed the topsails at 10 A.M. took in misen topsail, so ends this day heading S. by W. Lat by Obs 15.5-6 Lon 15.2

Tuesday Nov 8th

Commences with strong breezes from W.S.W. heading S.W. under close reefed topsails, reefed main sail middle parts squally at day light shook out reefs set 1st & main sail, spanker & c. squally, set top gallant sail at 11 took him, so ends this day rugged Course W. Lat by Obs Lon by Obs 15.3

Wednesday Nov 9th

Commences with the squally weather at 2 P.M. clewed down double reefed took in 1st & main sail, at 6 close reefed, the topsails took in fore & misen middle parts blowing hard at 11 A.M. set fore sail, so ends this day, Course West by S. Lat by Obs 15.9-15.5 Lon by Obs 15.4

Thursday Nov 10th

Commences with moderate weather set close reefed topsails, at 4 P.M. whole topsails, & a reefed main sail middle parts squally, clewed down double reefed the fore and misen topsails at day light squally latter parts strong breezes from N.W. so ends this day with all sail out Course W.S.W. Lat by Obs 15.5-15.4 Lon 15.5 days

Friday Nov 11th

Commences with strong breezes from N.W. at 2 P.M. clewed down double reefed & c. middle parts squally at 8 A.M. have too under close reefed main topsails & stay sails so ends this blowing a gale Course W. by S. Lat by Obs 16.0-16.4 Lon 15.6

Saturday Nov 12th

Commences with rugged weather lying too, middle parts squally at day light set fore top sail at 7 wore ship rugged latter parts same so ends this day bad weather Course N.W. Lat by Obs Lon 15.7

Sunday Nov 13th

Commences with strong breezes from West, steering N.W. with close reefed topsails, & reefed main sail middle parts squally with hail & snow at 8 A.M. set 1st. Shook out one reef from fore & main top sail latter parts same so ends this day rugged Course N.W. Lat by Obs Lon by Obs 15.8

Monday Nov 14th

Commences with strong breezes from W.S.W. heading N.W. at 8 P.M. gave her whole topsail & top gallant sail, at 2 A.M. clewed down & double reefed, at 7 A.M. took in 1st, reefed the main sail latter blowing hard took in fore sail, furlled fore & misen topsails, so ends this day lying too 15.9 Course S.W. by S. Lat by Obs 15.9-15.5 Lon 15.9

Tuesday Nov 15th

Commences with a gale from West lying too under close reefed main top sail, & reefed fore sail, middle parts same at 4 P.M. took in fore sail, latter parts same so ends this day Course S.W. by S. Lat by Obs 16.0-16.6 Lon by Obs 16.0

Wednesday Nov 16th

Commences with rugged weather, wore ship to the N.W. at 4 P.M. gave her whole topsails, fore top mast standing sail, middle parts squally, took in standing sail braced by ards at 7 P.M. strong breezes from W.S.W. latter parts same, so ends this day Course N.W. Lat by Obs 16.1

Thursday Nov 17th

Commences with strong breezes from W.S.W. clewed down and double reefed, at 3 P.M. close reefed topsails & reefed the main sail middle parts squally turned out one reef from fore & main top sail latter parts same so ends this
